Tampere Central Region

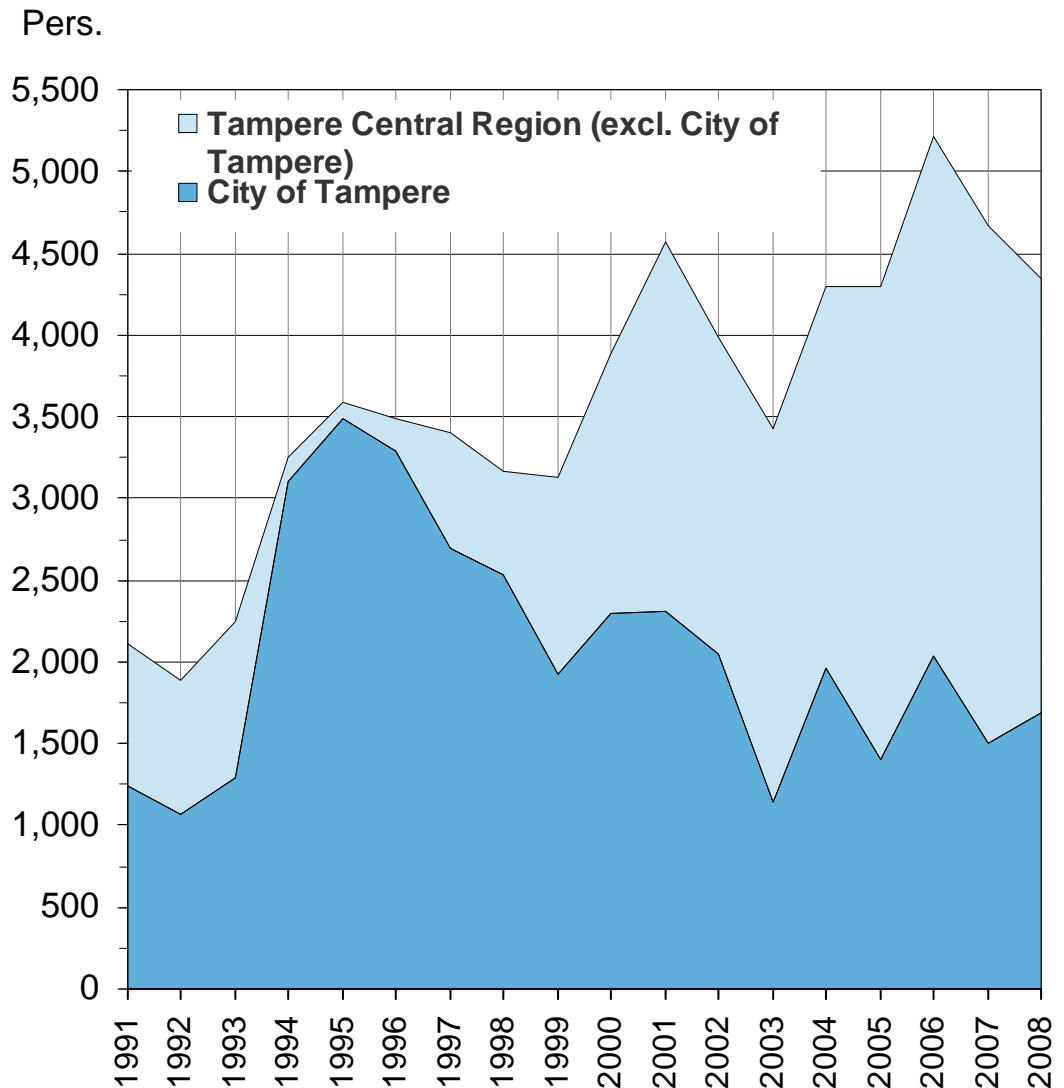
- Tampere Central Region consists of the municipalities of Kangasala, Lempäälä, Pirkkala and Vesilahti, and the cities of Nokia, Orivesi, Tampere and Ylöjärvi.
- The population of Tampere Central Region in 2008 was 348,274, which is 6.5 % of population of Finland.
- Tampere Central Region is the most significant region in Finland after Helsinki Region

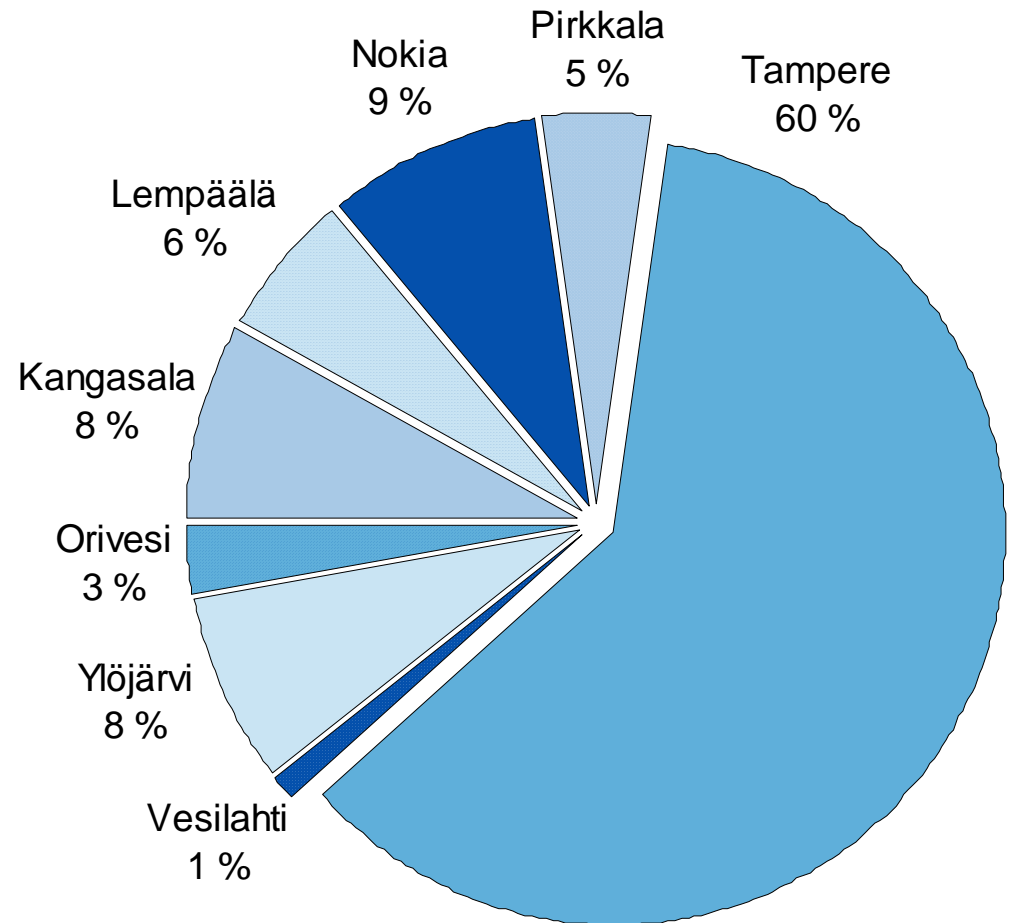

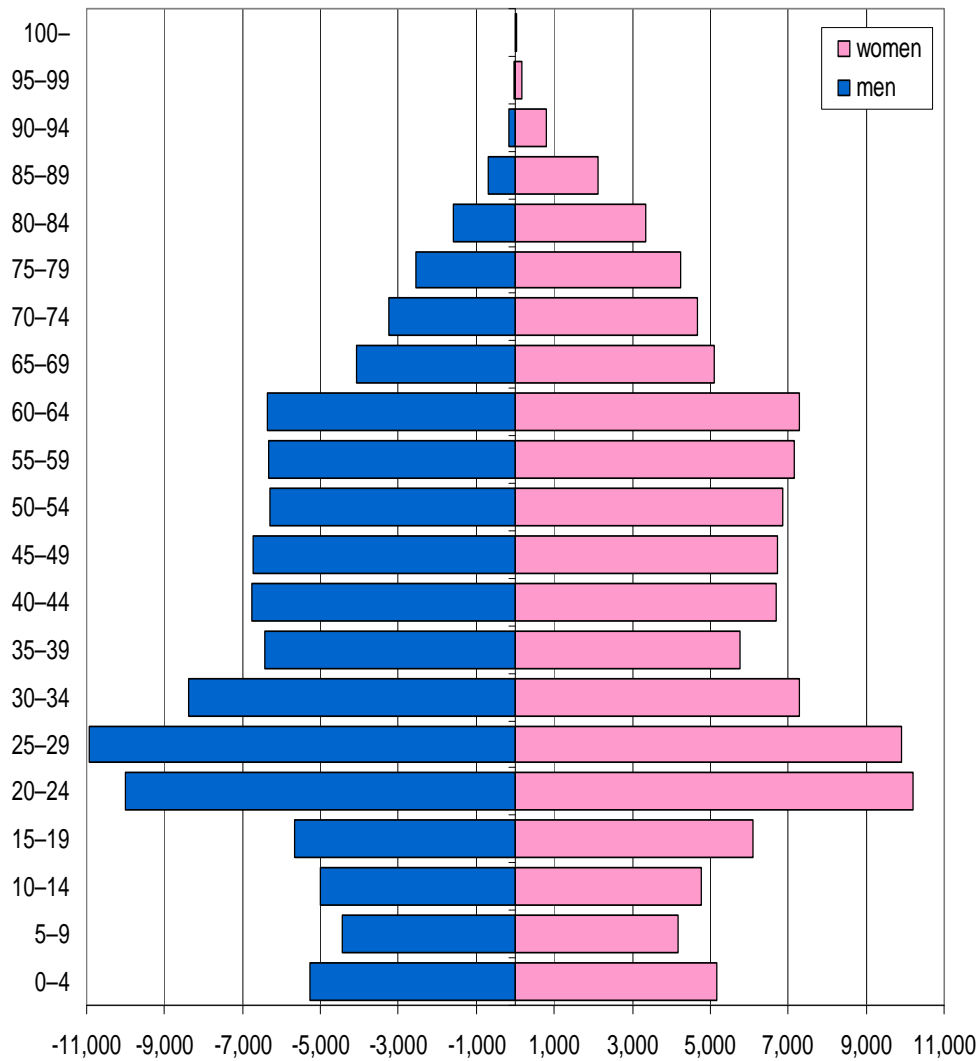

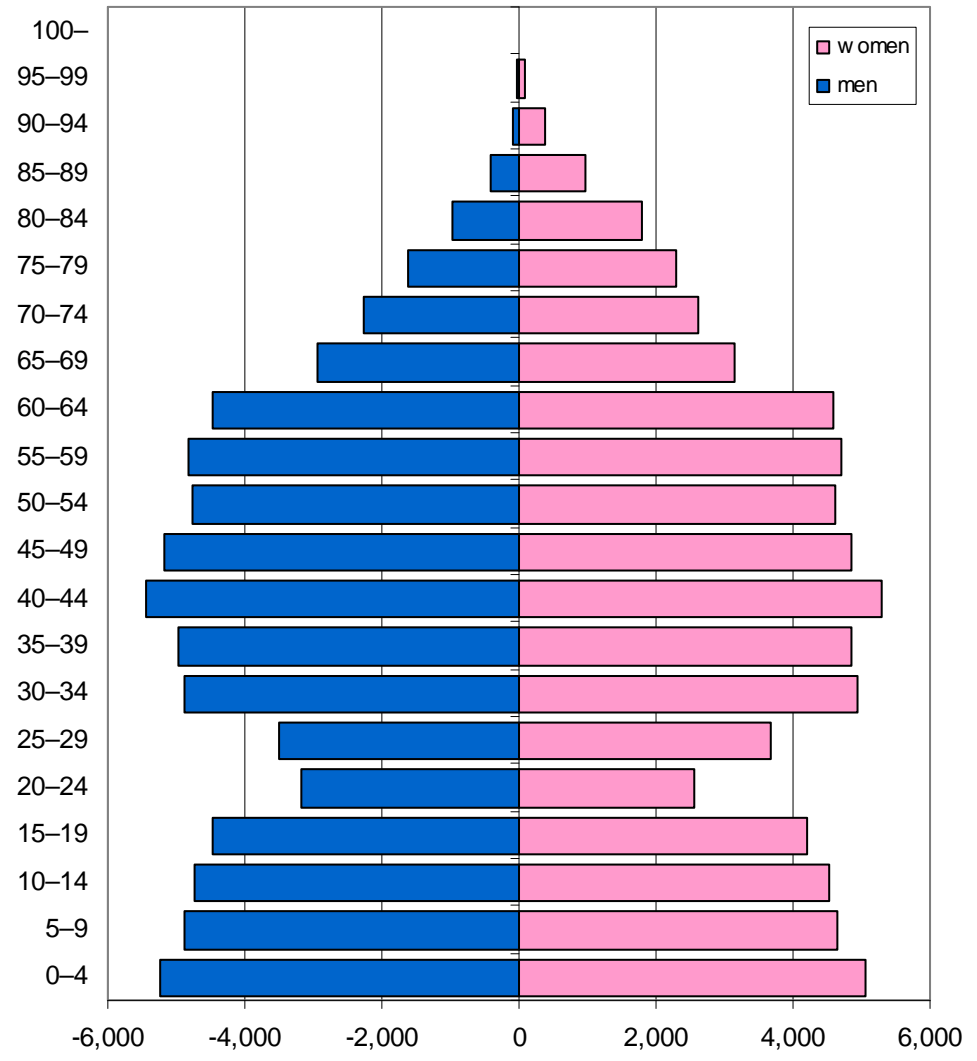


Population 2008

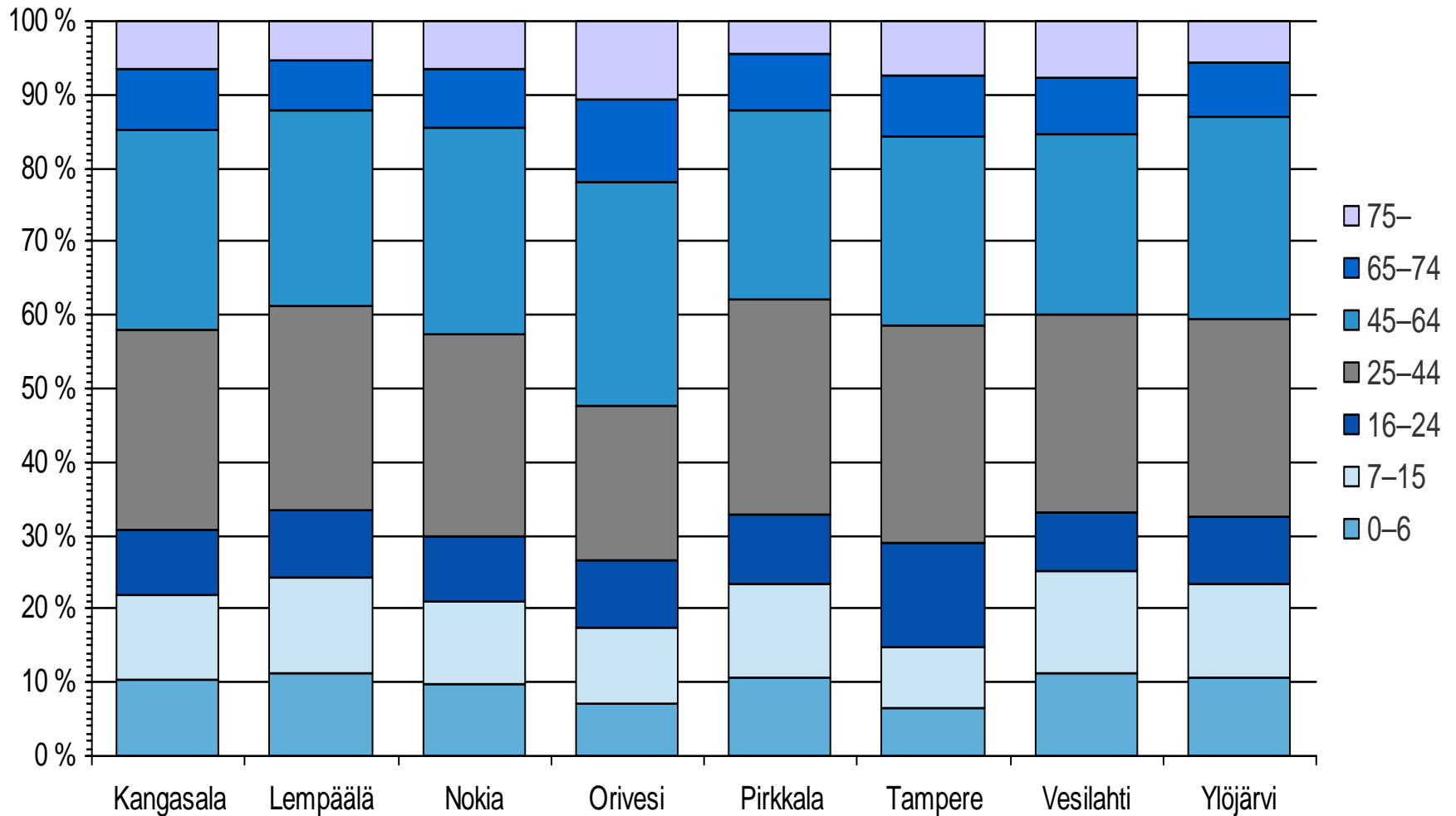

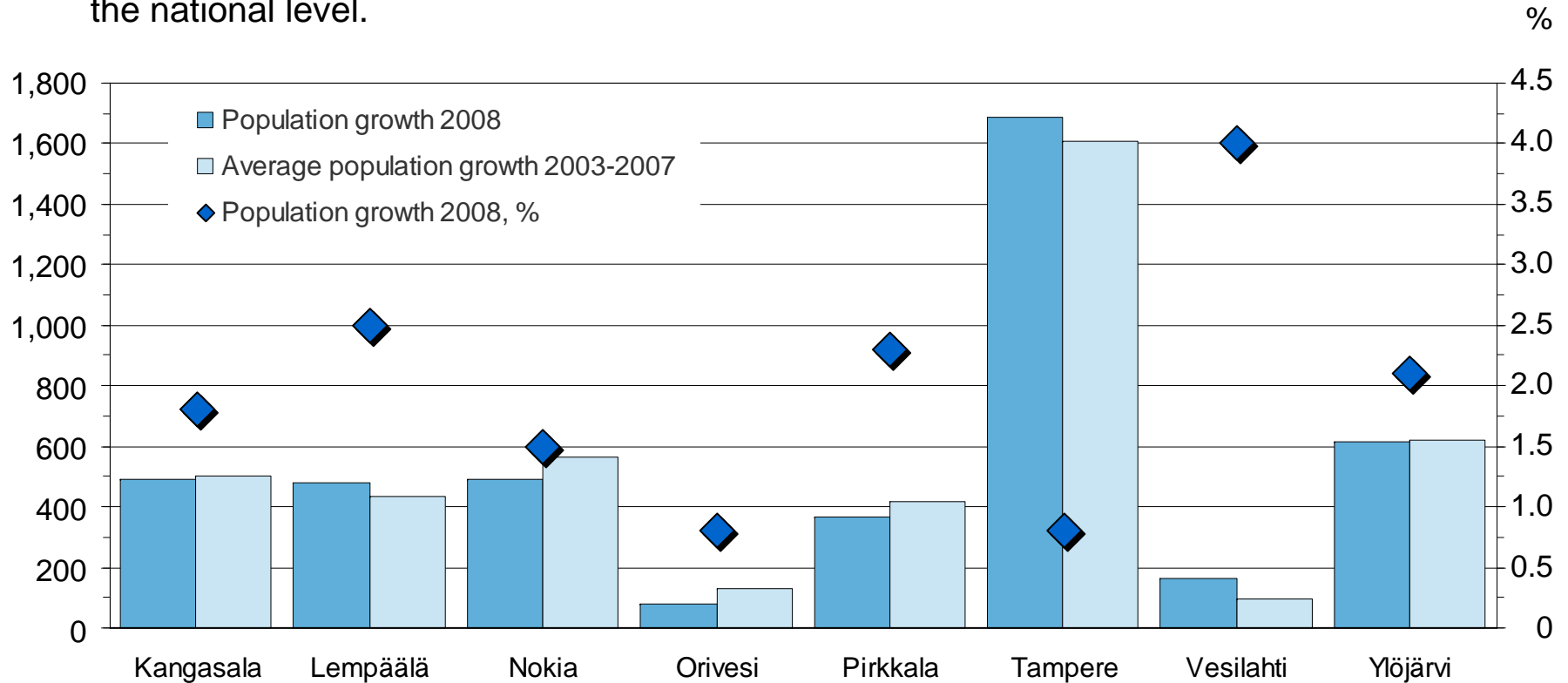

Population growth 2008

- Population of Tampere Central Region increased in total 4,342 (+1.3 %). The increase was largest in Tampere, 1,686.
- The largest population growth relative to the size of the population was seen in Vesilahti. The rate of the population growth was also rapid in Lempäälä, Pirkkala and Ylöjärvi compared to the national level.

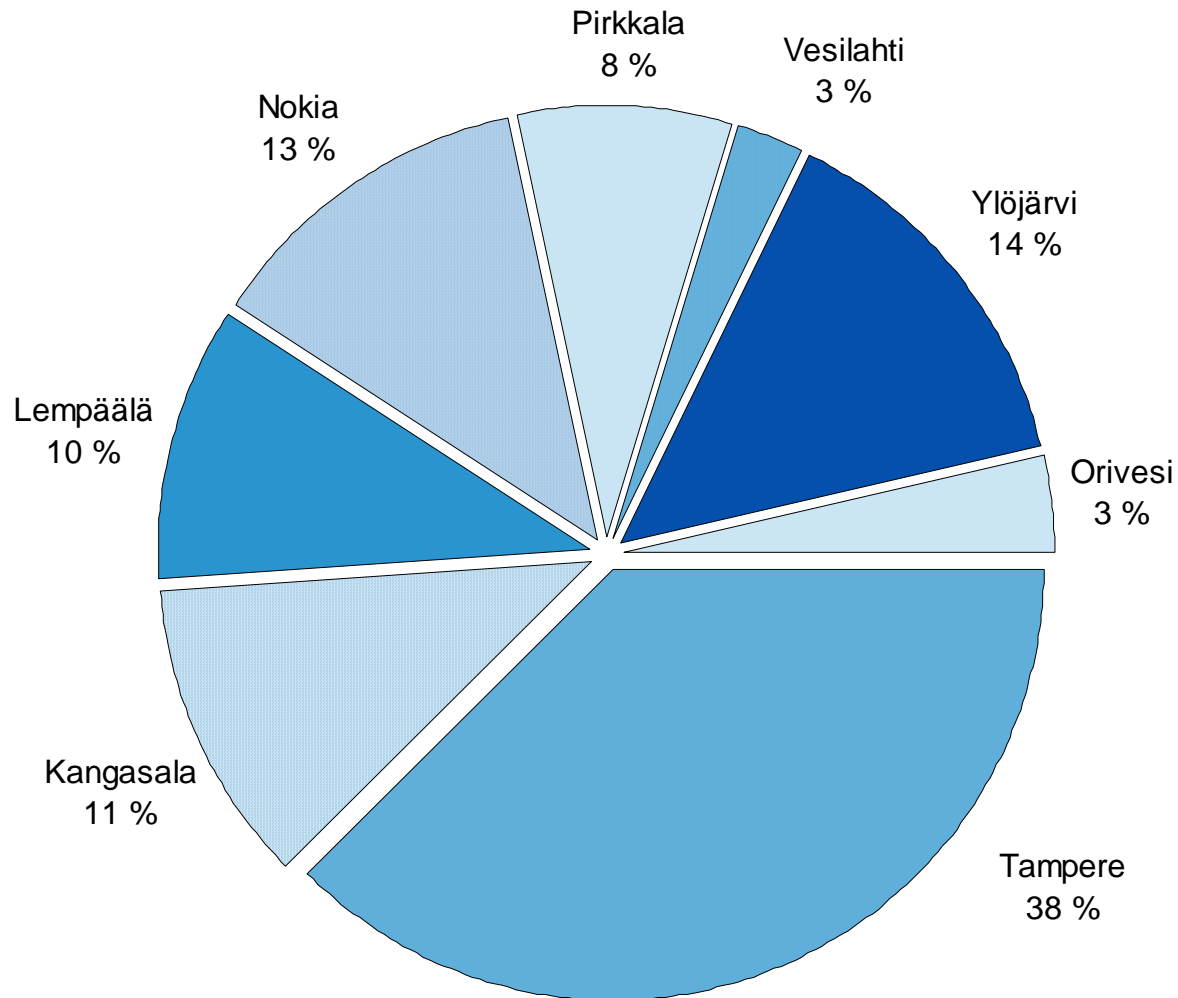

Total increase of population +22,813, average +4,563/year

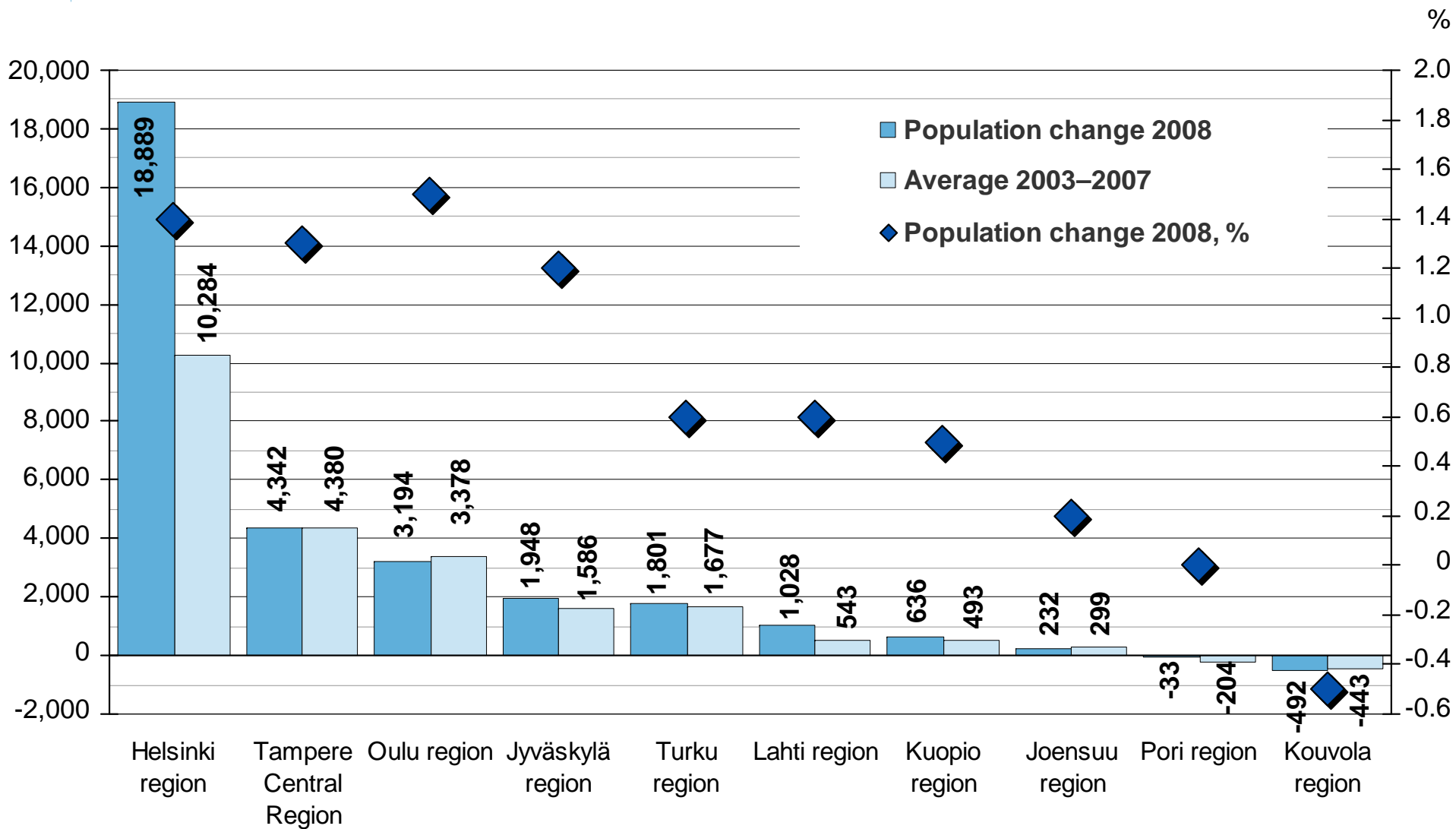

10 largest regions



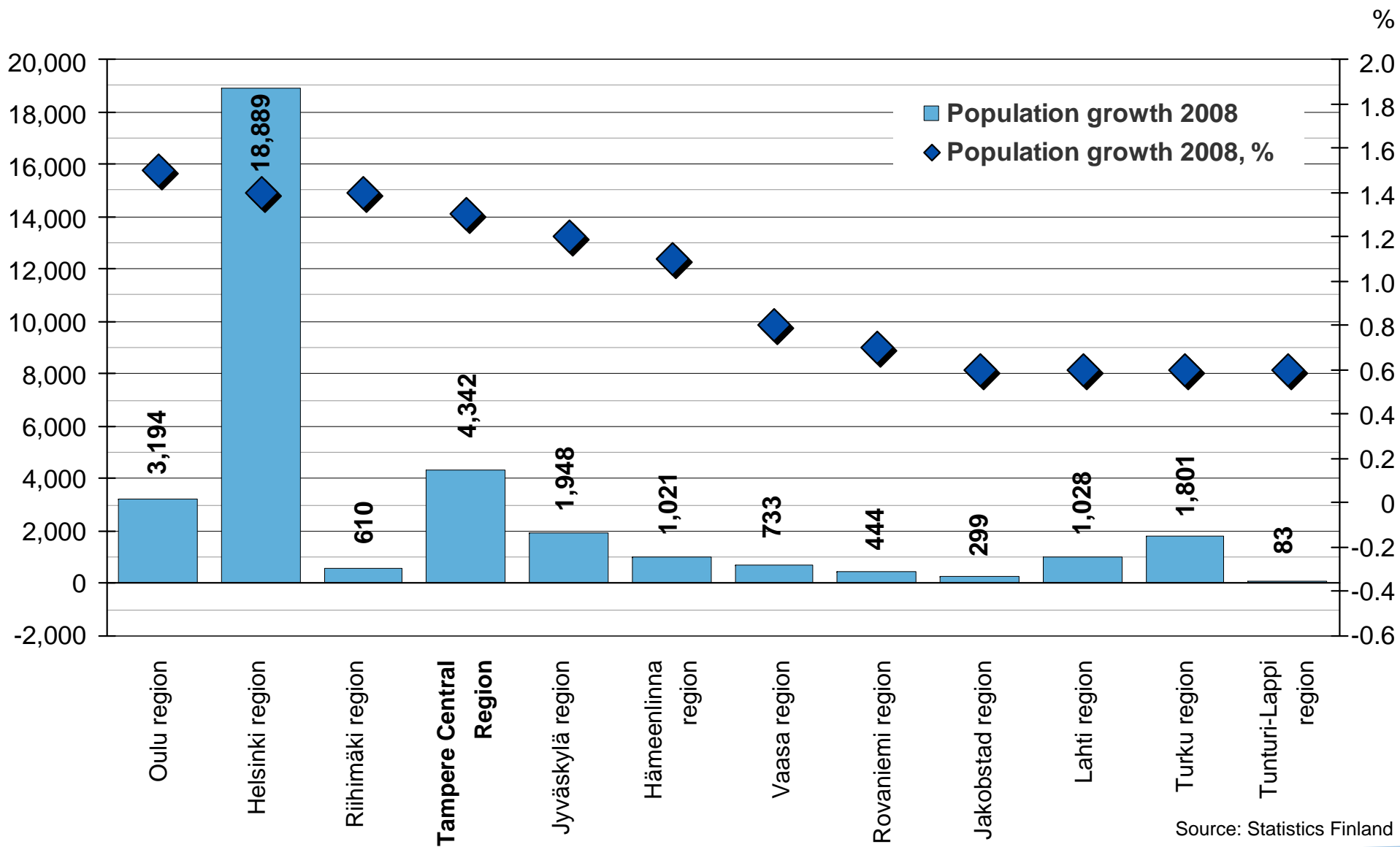

12 regions with fastest rate of relative population growth

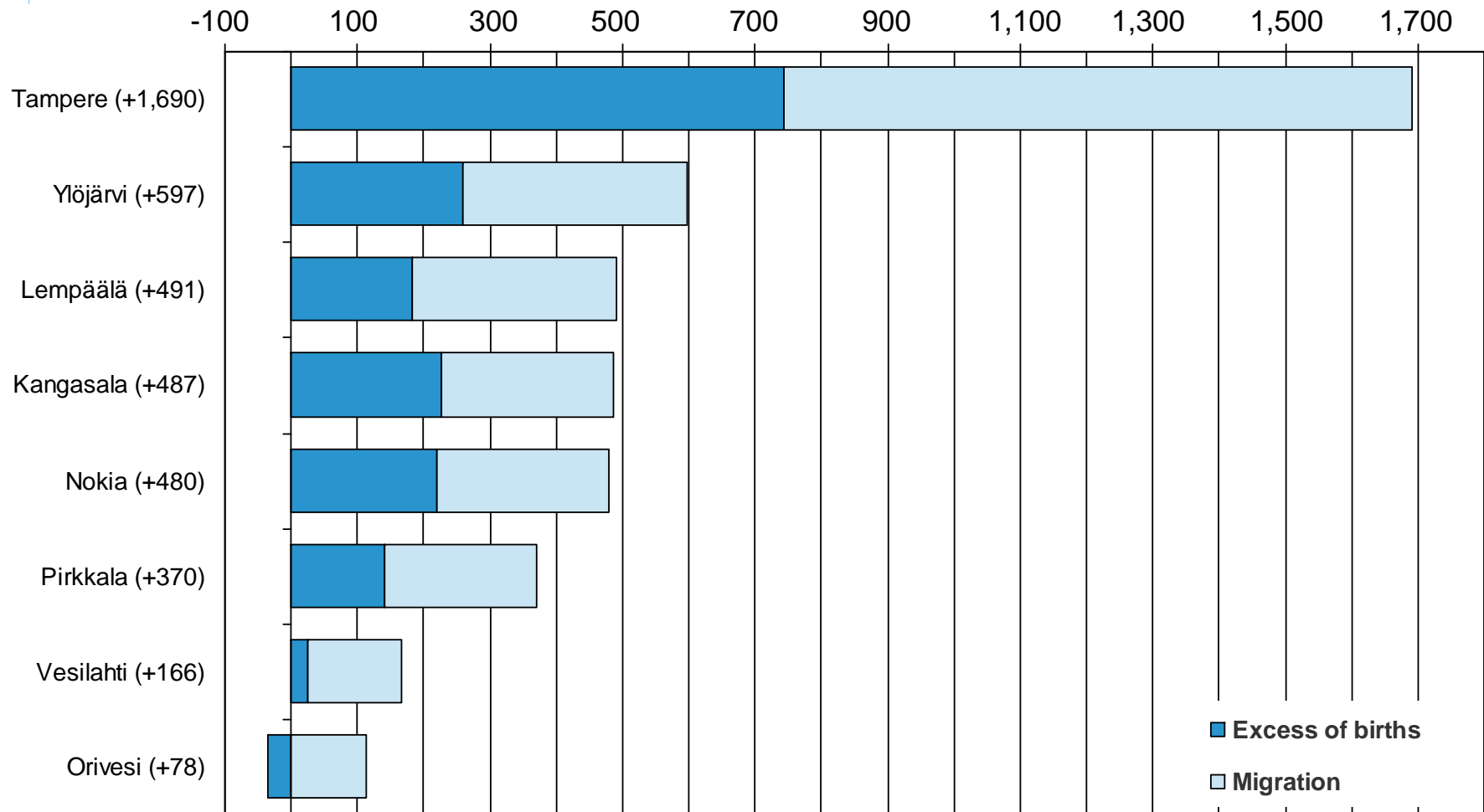

Population change in Tampere Central Region 2008

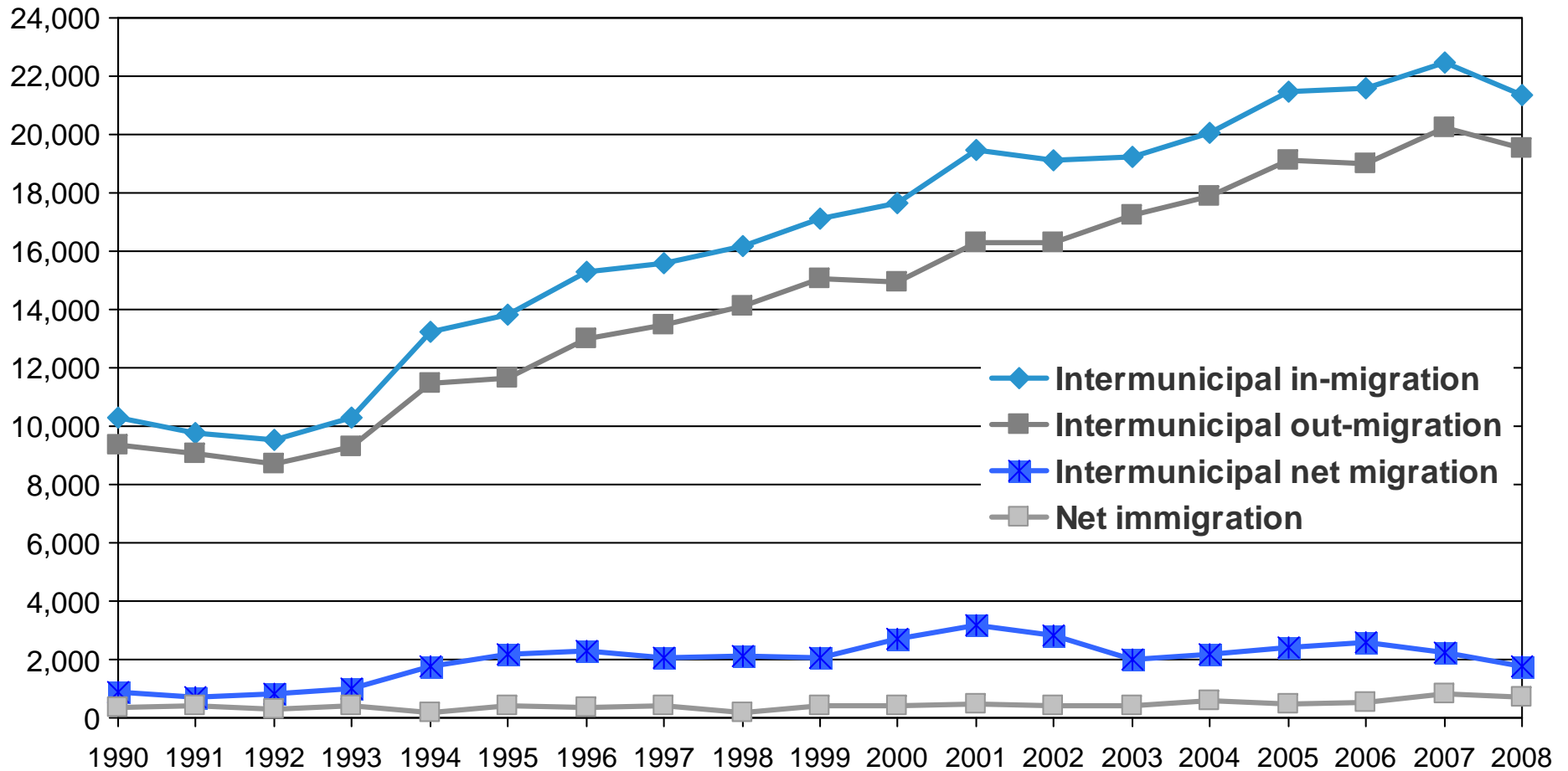

Migration in Tampere Central Region 1990–2008



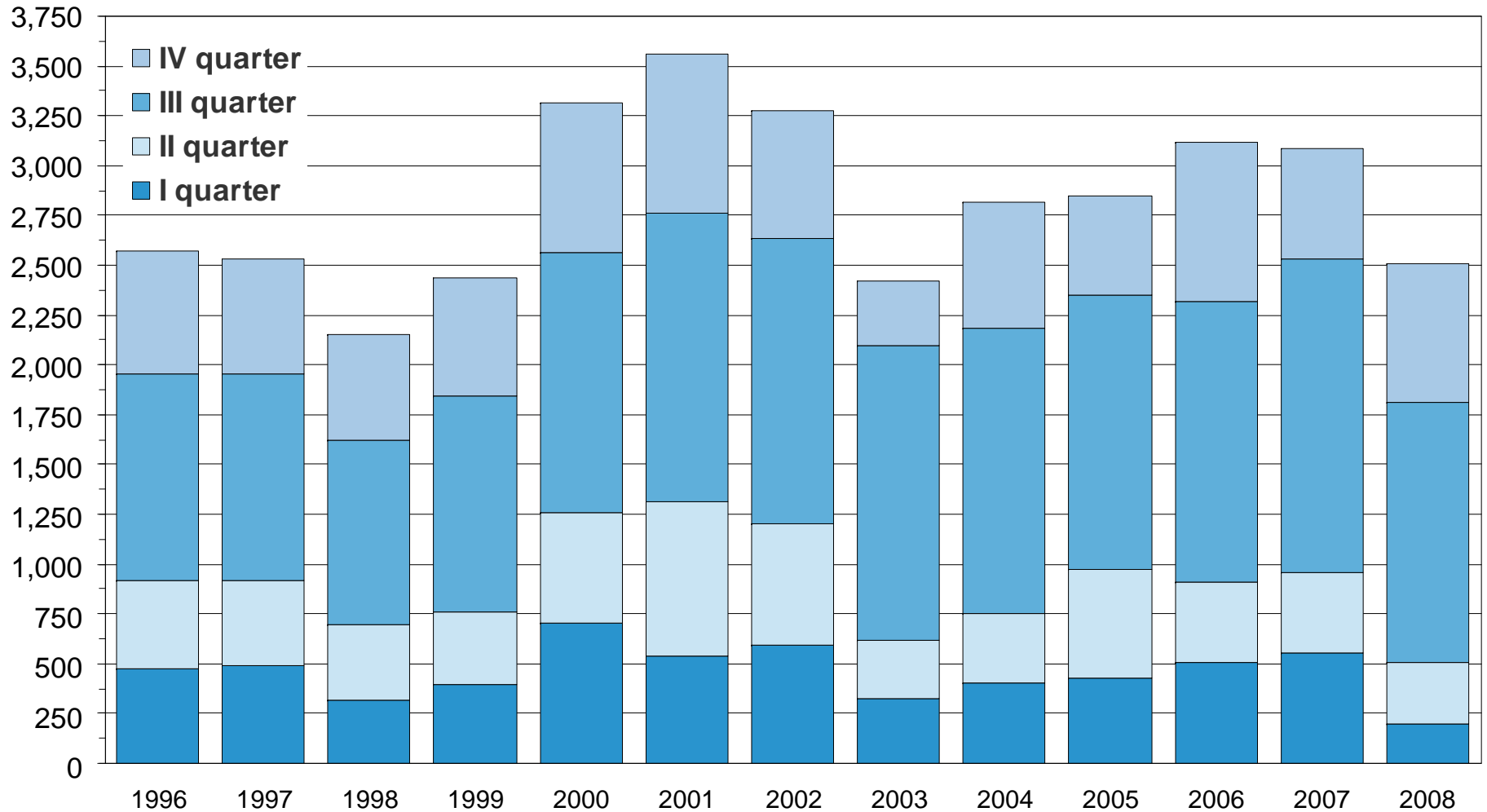

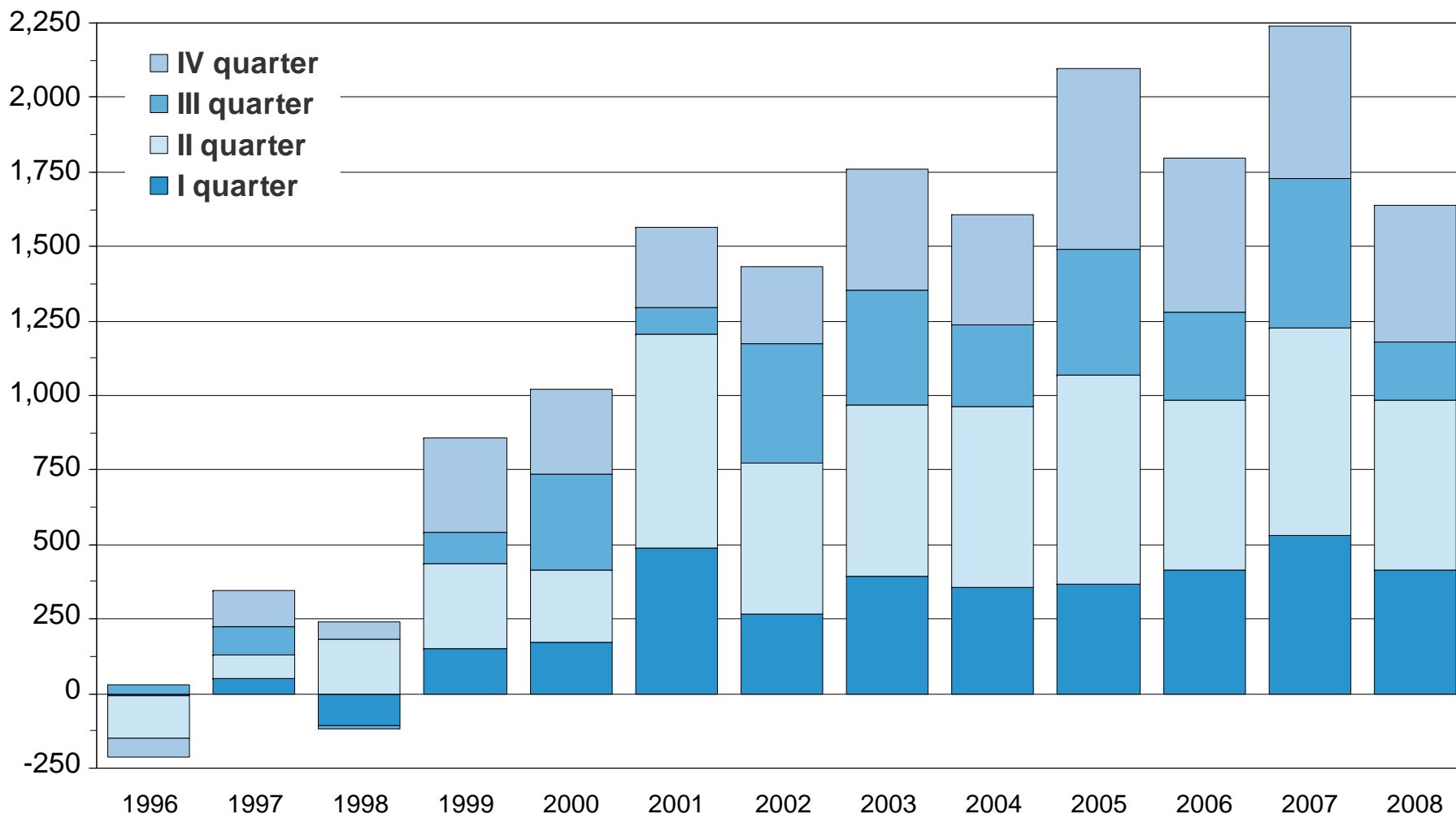

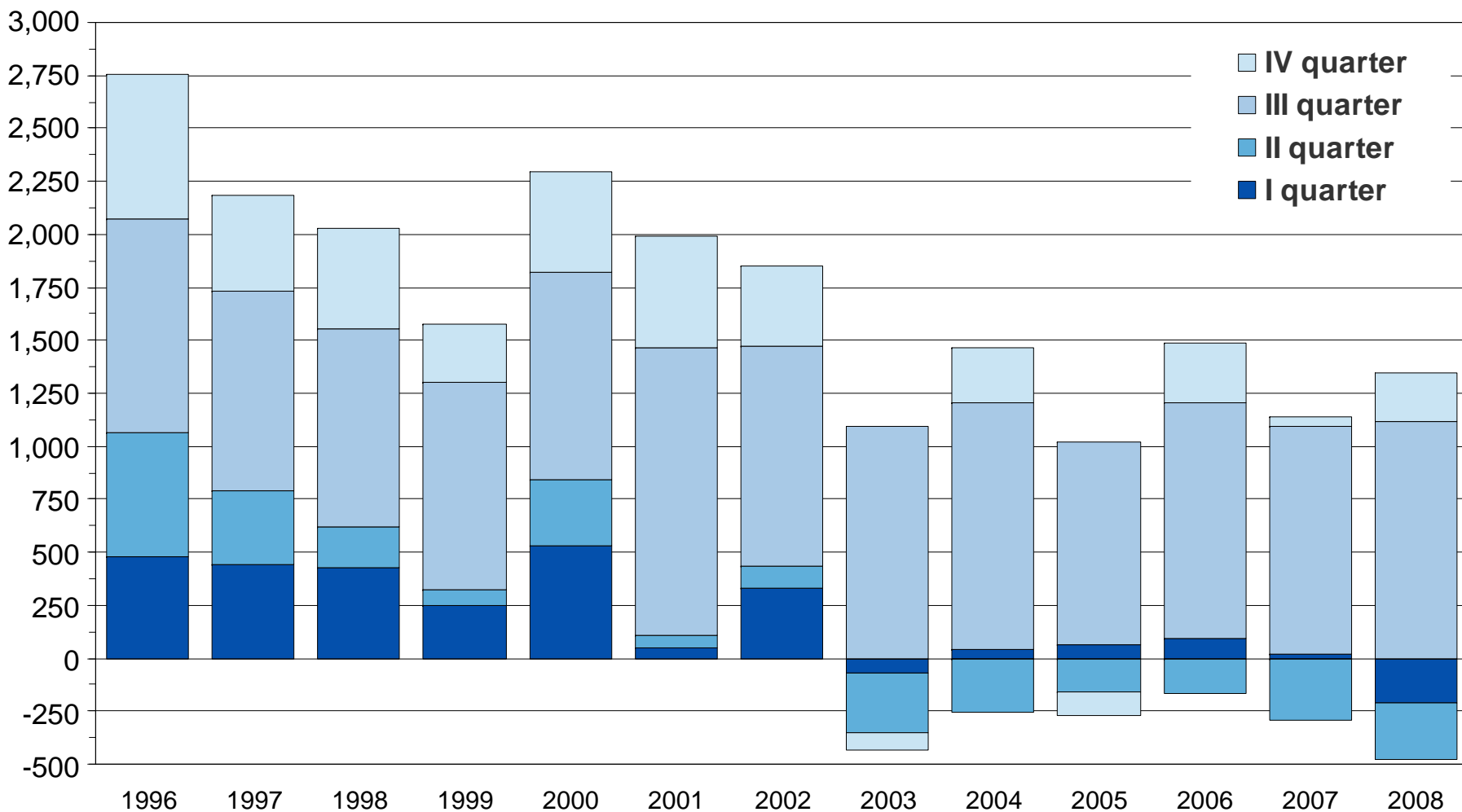

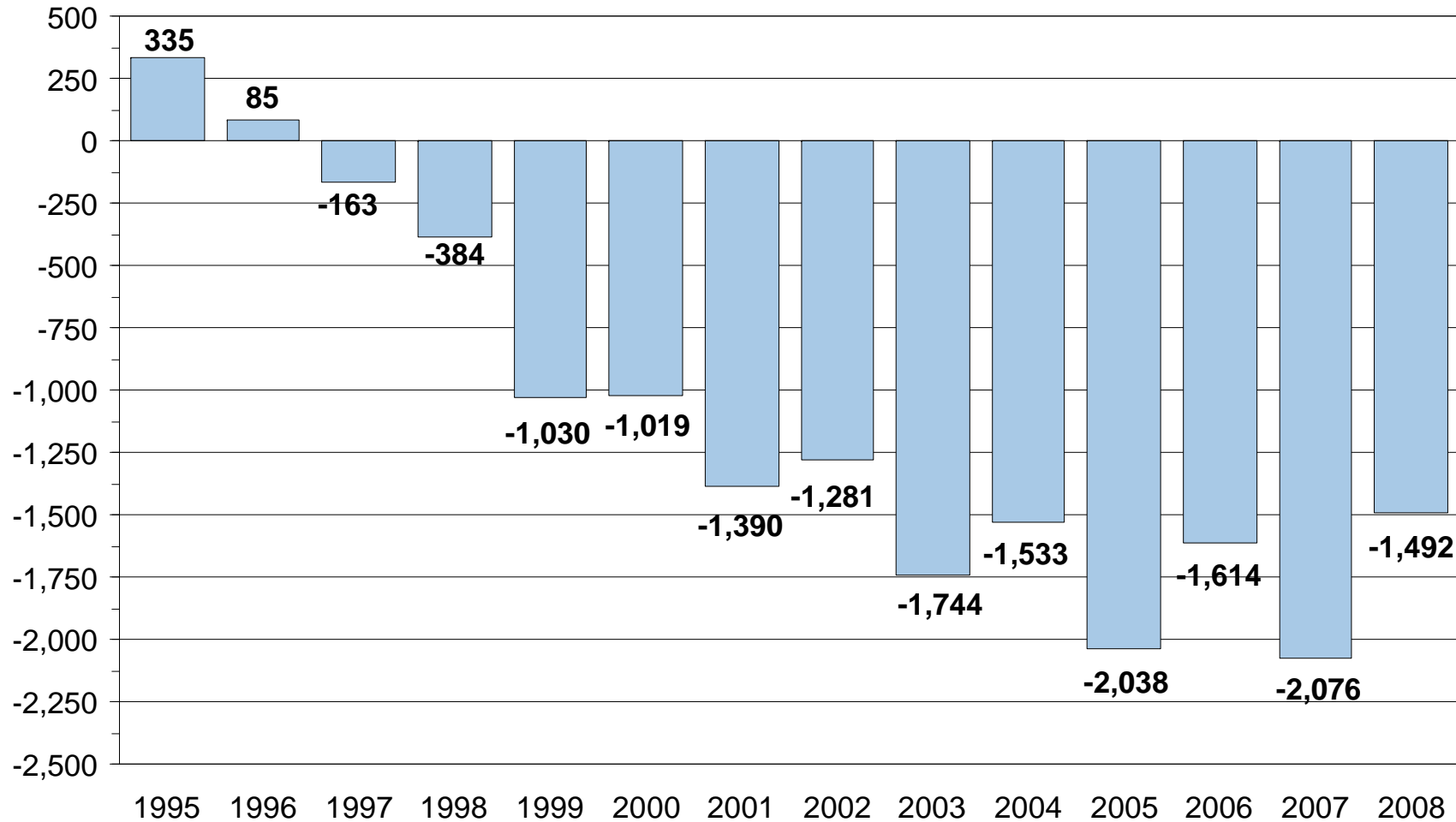

Net migration from Tampere to the other municipalities* of Tampere Central Region 1995–2008



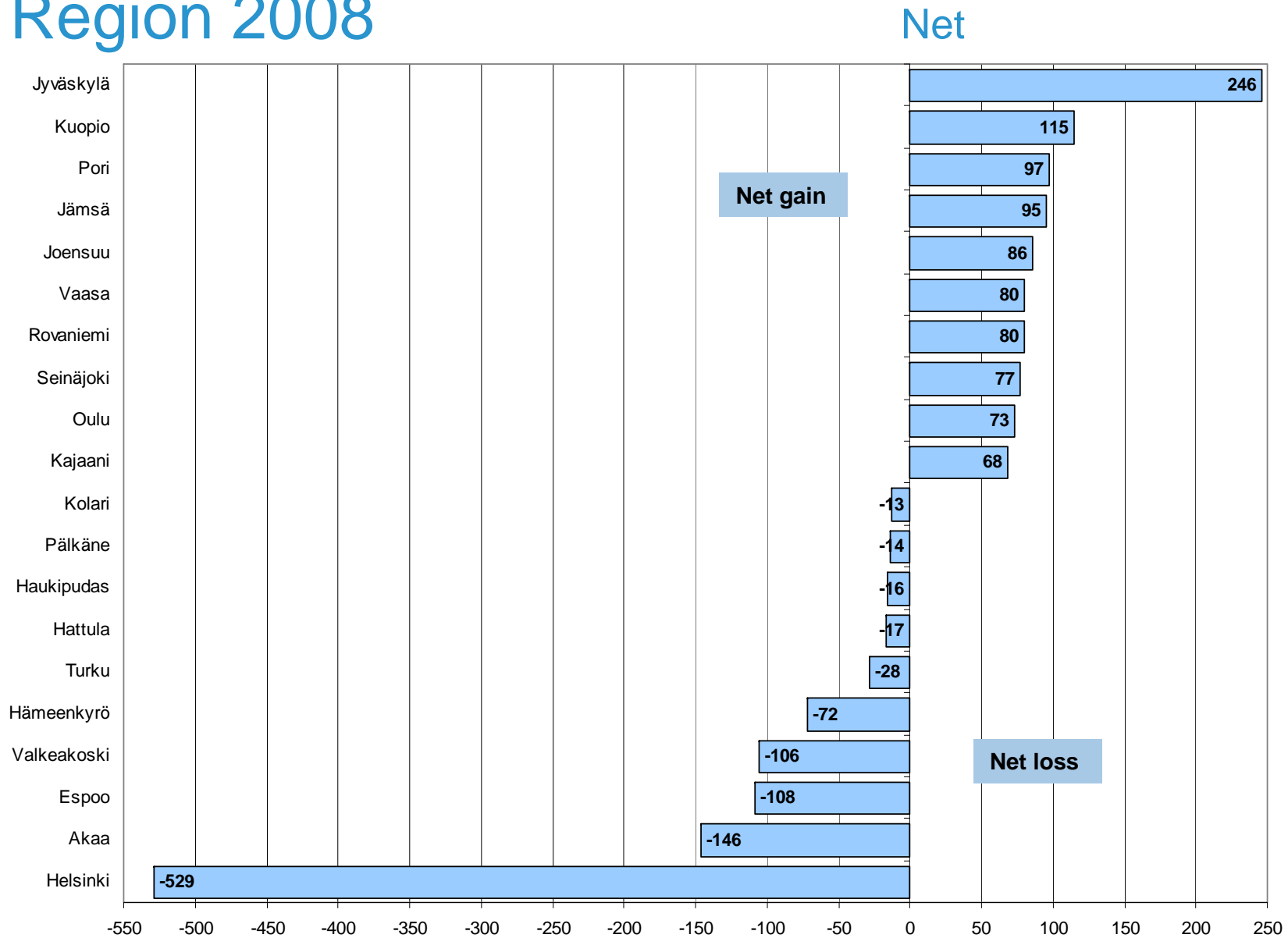

Migration gain and loss in Tampere Central Region 2008



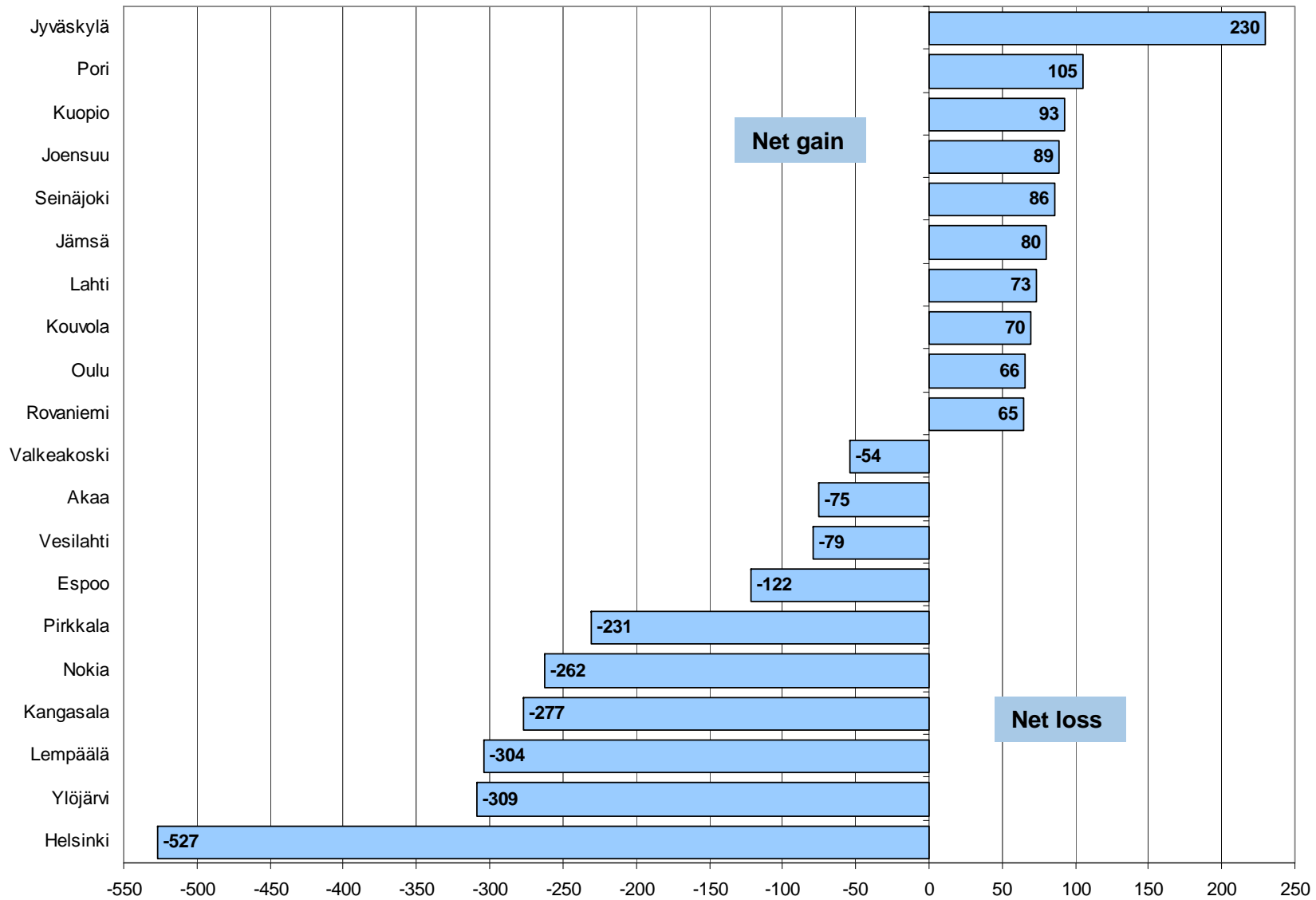

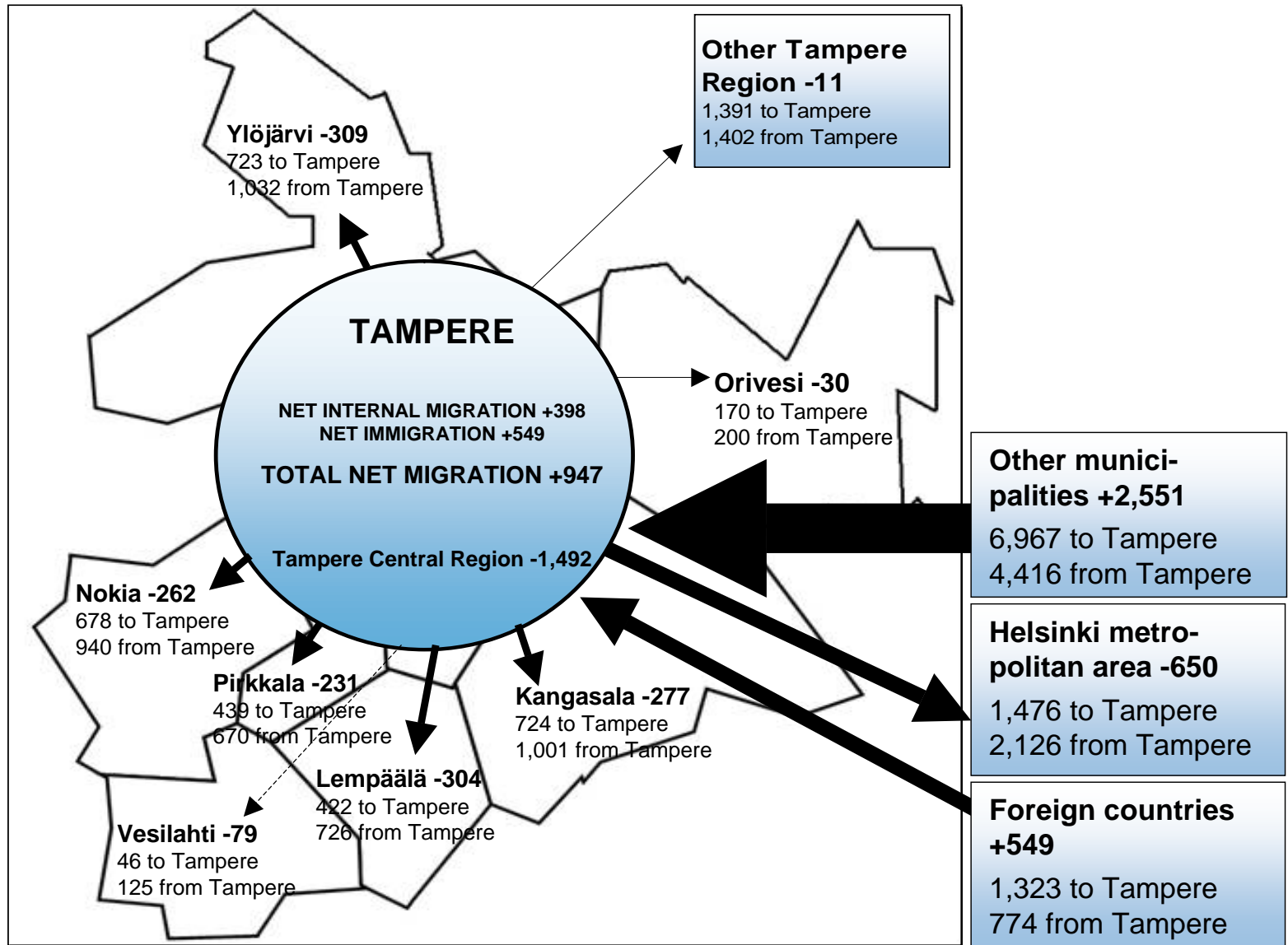

Net migration by direction in Tampere 2008

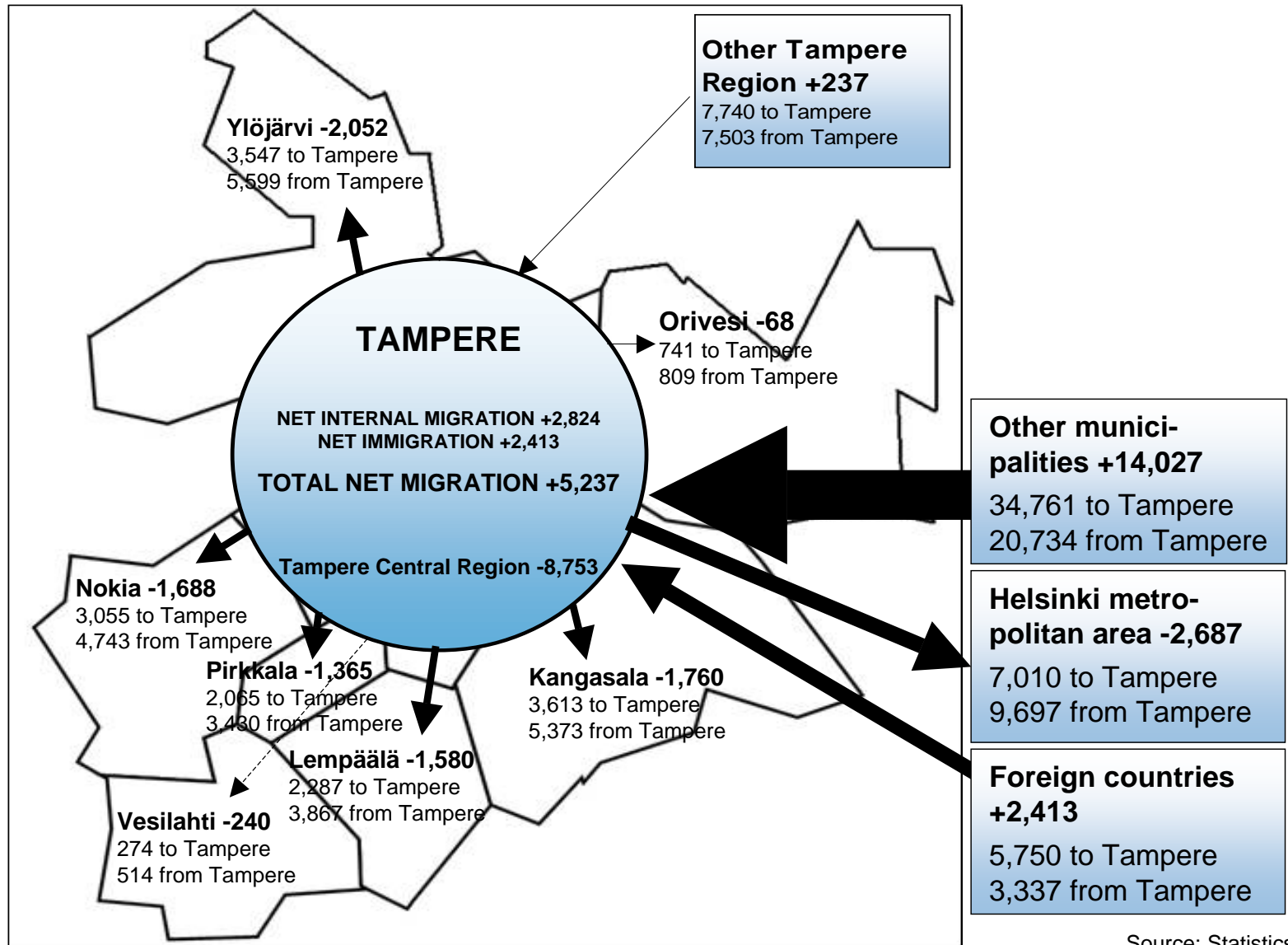

Net migration by direction in Tampere 2004–2008



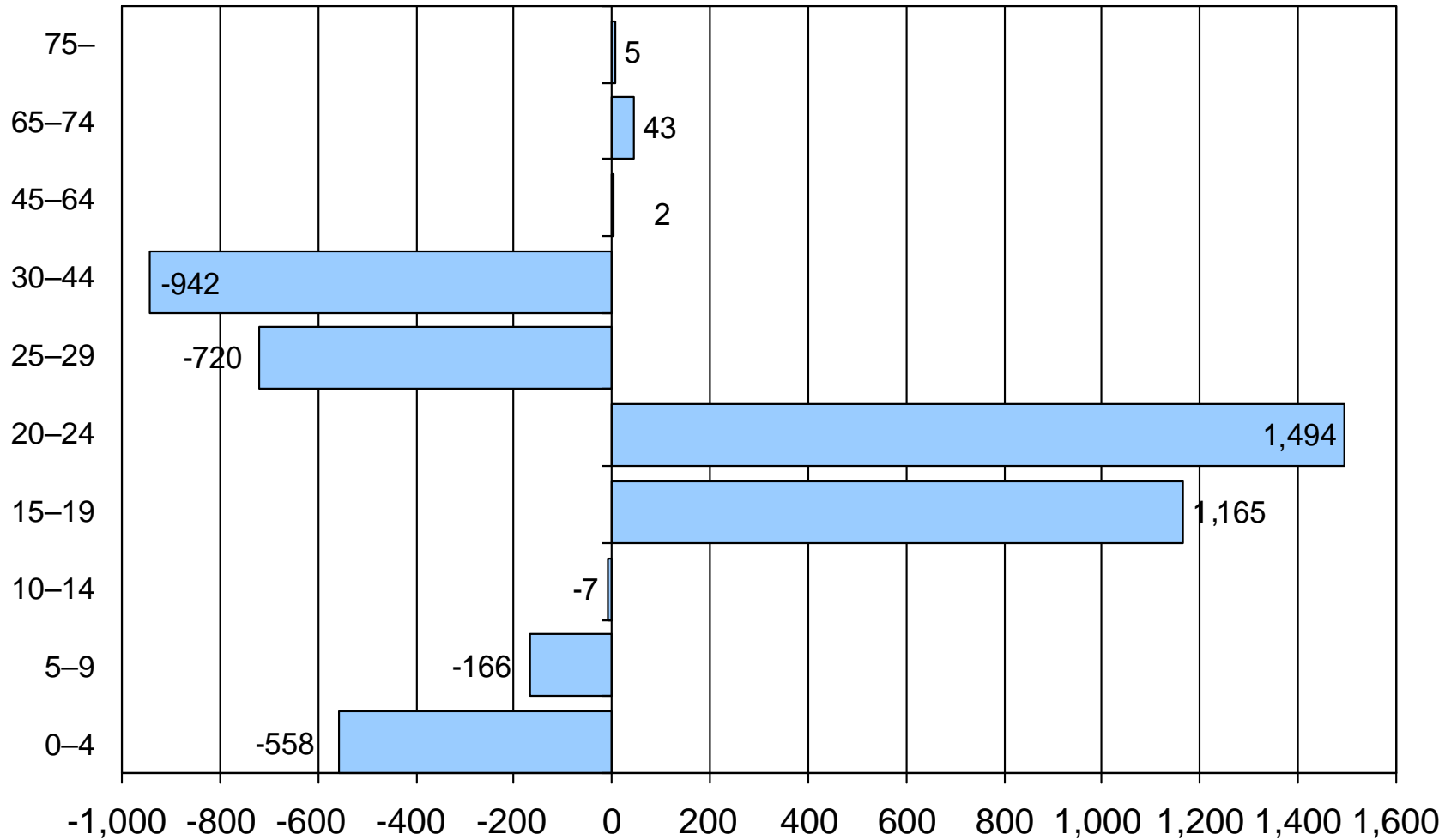

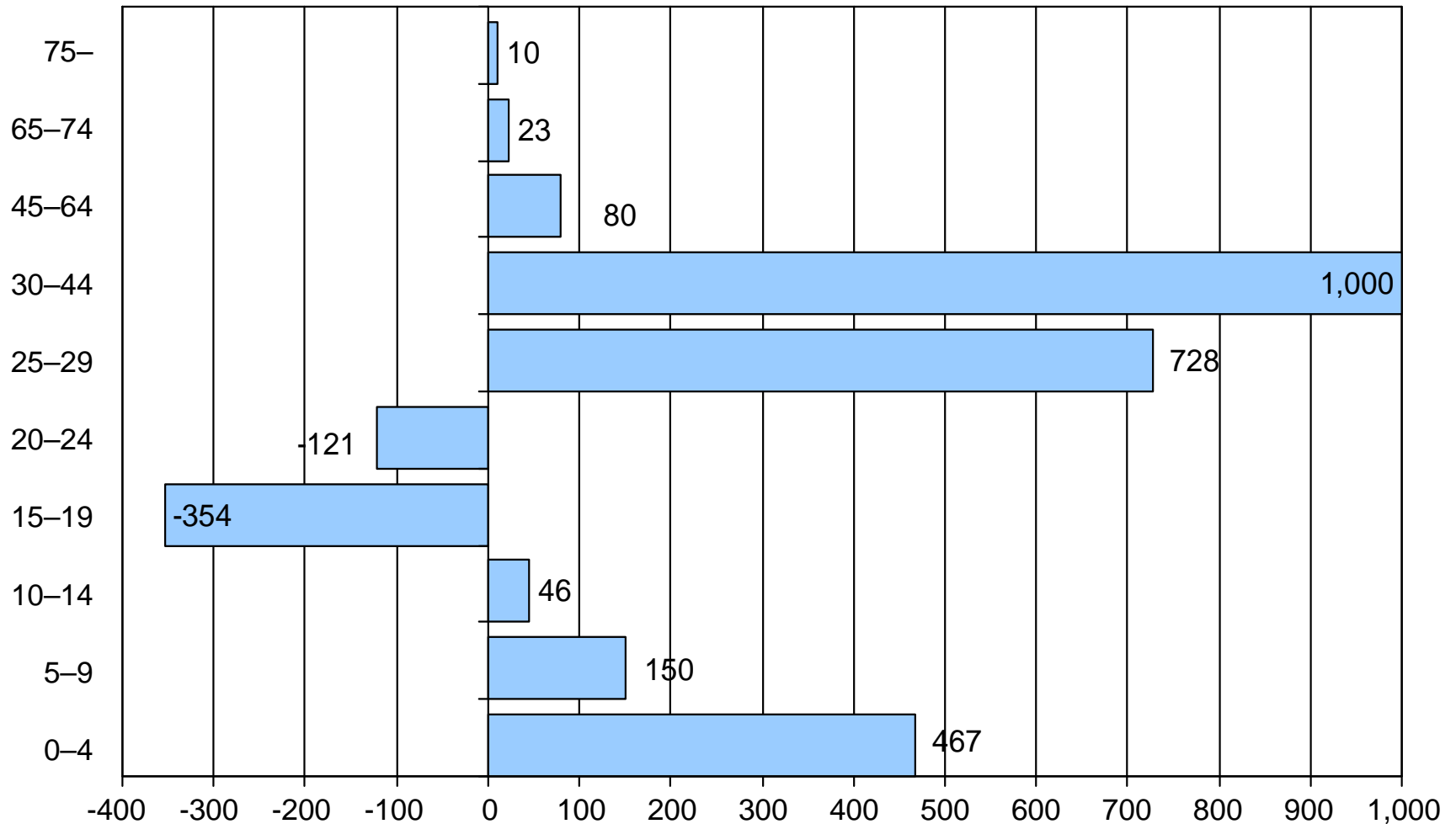

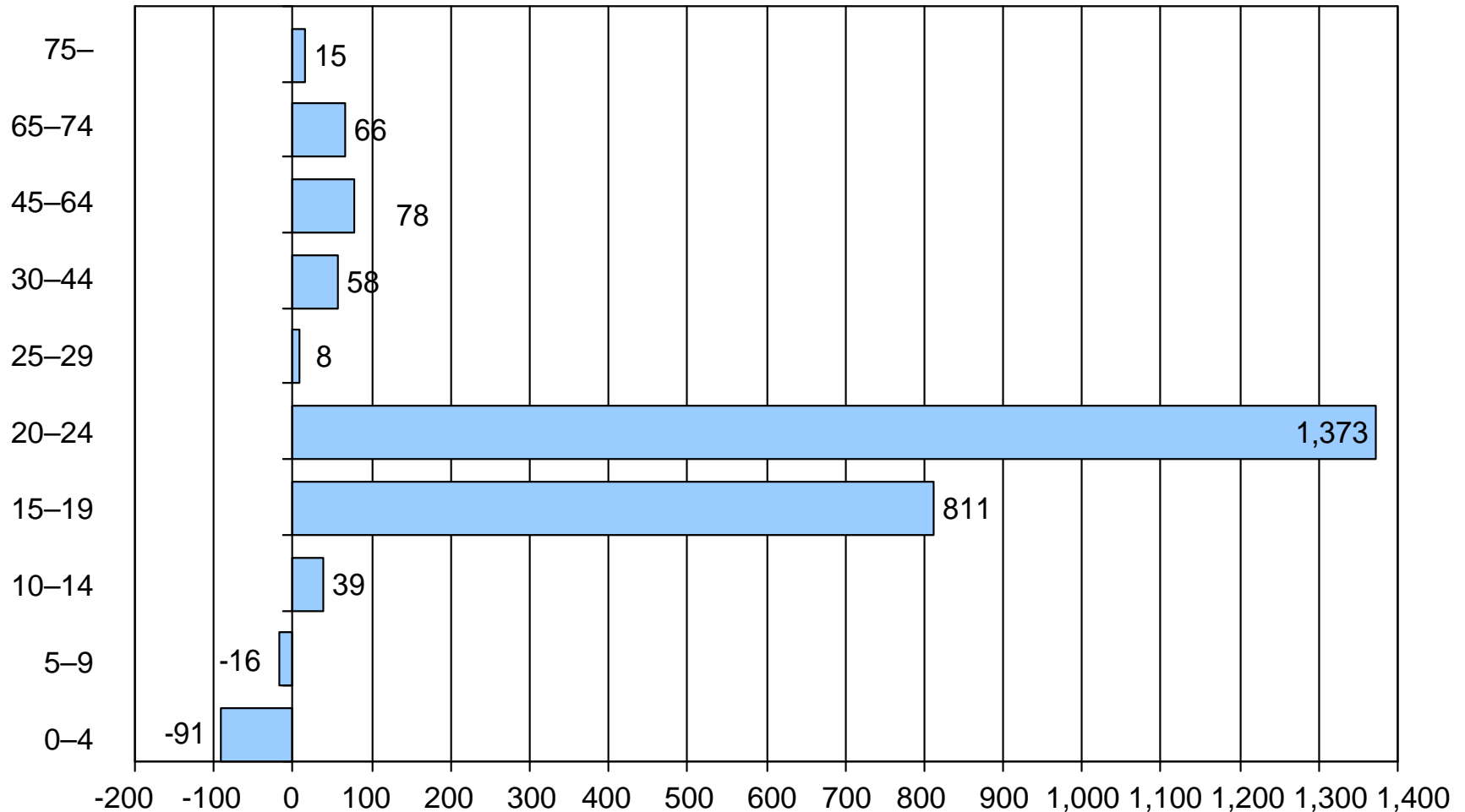

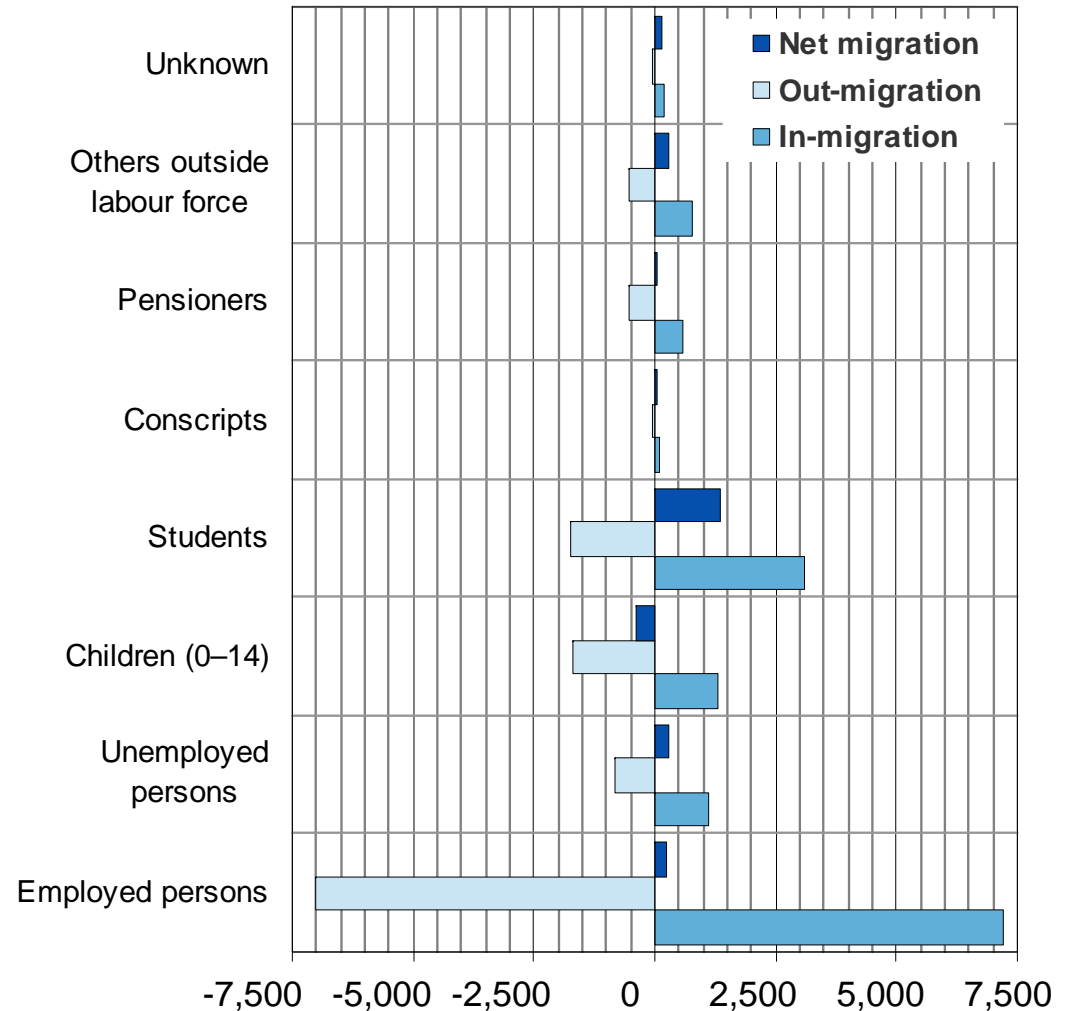

Migration by field of activity in Tampere 2006

- Migration gain of employed persons was 224. Two thirds of the out-migrated employees were between 25 and 44 years of age.
- Migration gain consisted mainly of students (+1,347) and unemployed persons (+360).
- Out-migration of families with children resulted in migration loss of 632 children under 15 years of age.
- Tampere had migration gain of 52 pensioners.



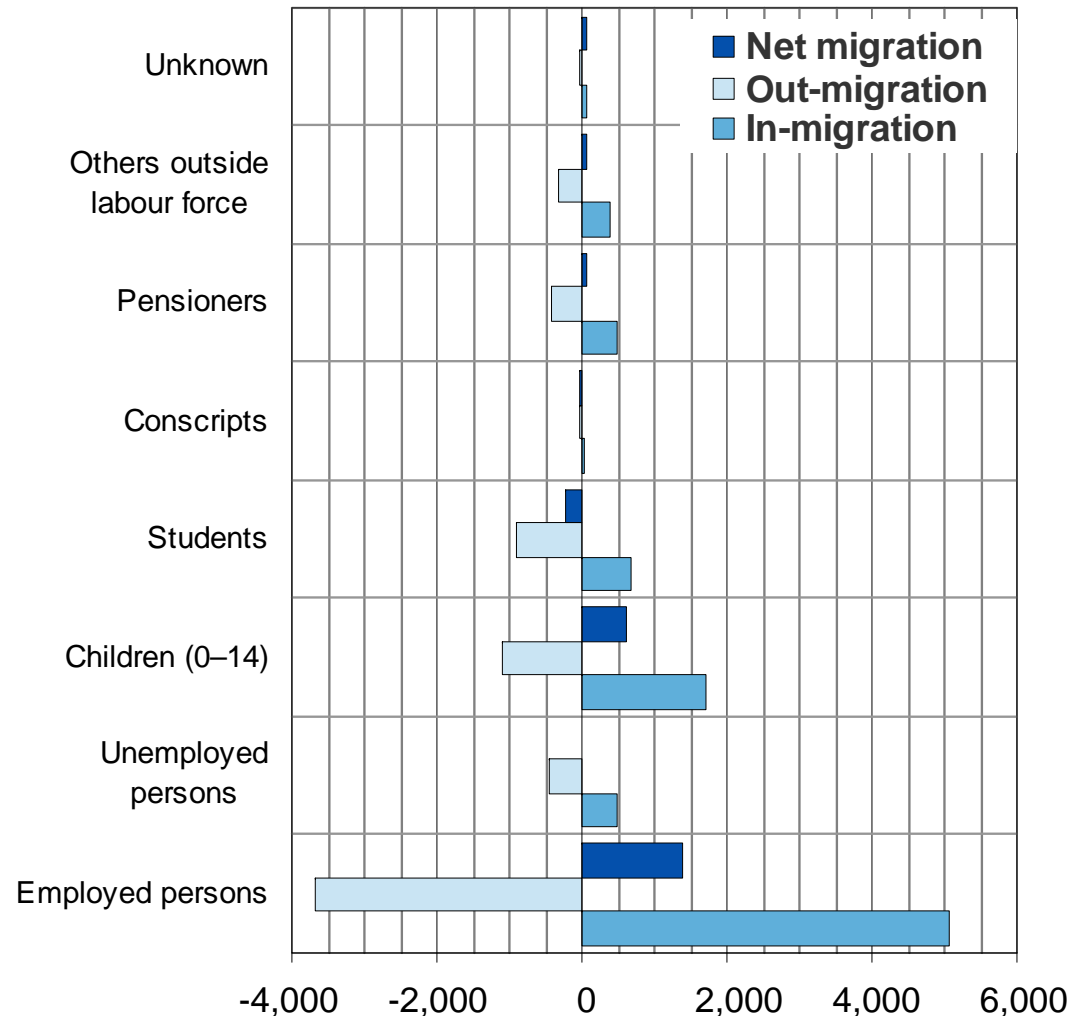

Migration by field of activity in Tampere Central Region 2006 (excluding City of Tampere)

- Migration gain consisted mostly of employed persons (+1,373) and children (+614).
- Students moved to Tampere and to other university cities (-222).
- Migration gain of pensioners was 59.

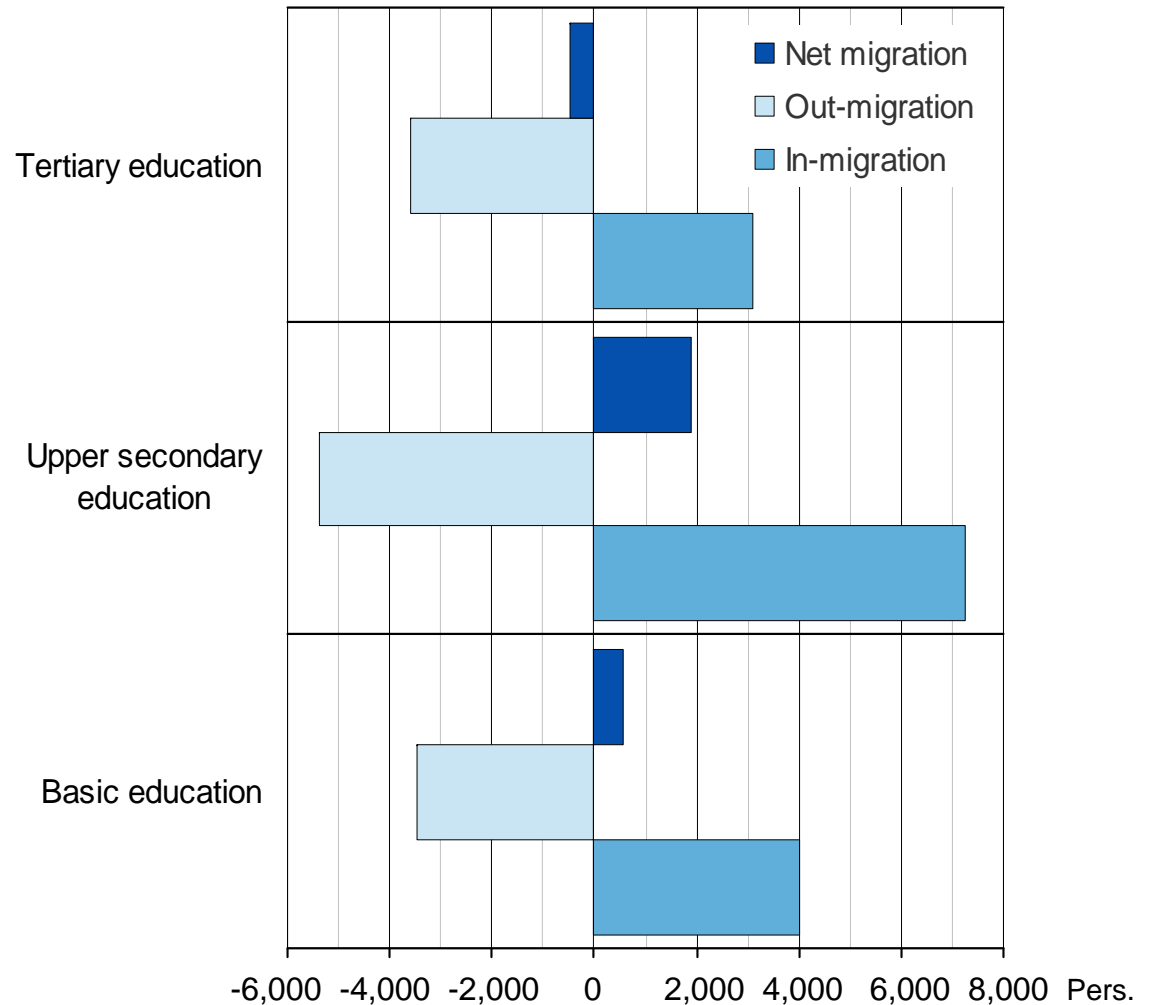




Migration by level of education in Tampere 2006

- In-migration was largest among persons with upper secondary education.
- Net migration of persons with tertiary education was negative.
- In Tampere Central Region net migration of persons with tertiary education was positive. Large group of people out-migrating from Tampere stayed within a travel-to-work area¹⁾.

¹⁾ A travel-to-work area is formed by a central municipality and surrounding municipalities from which at least 10 per cent of the labour force commute to the central municipality.

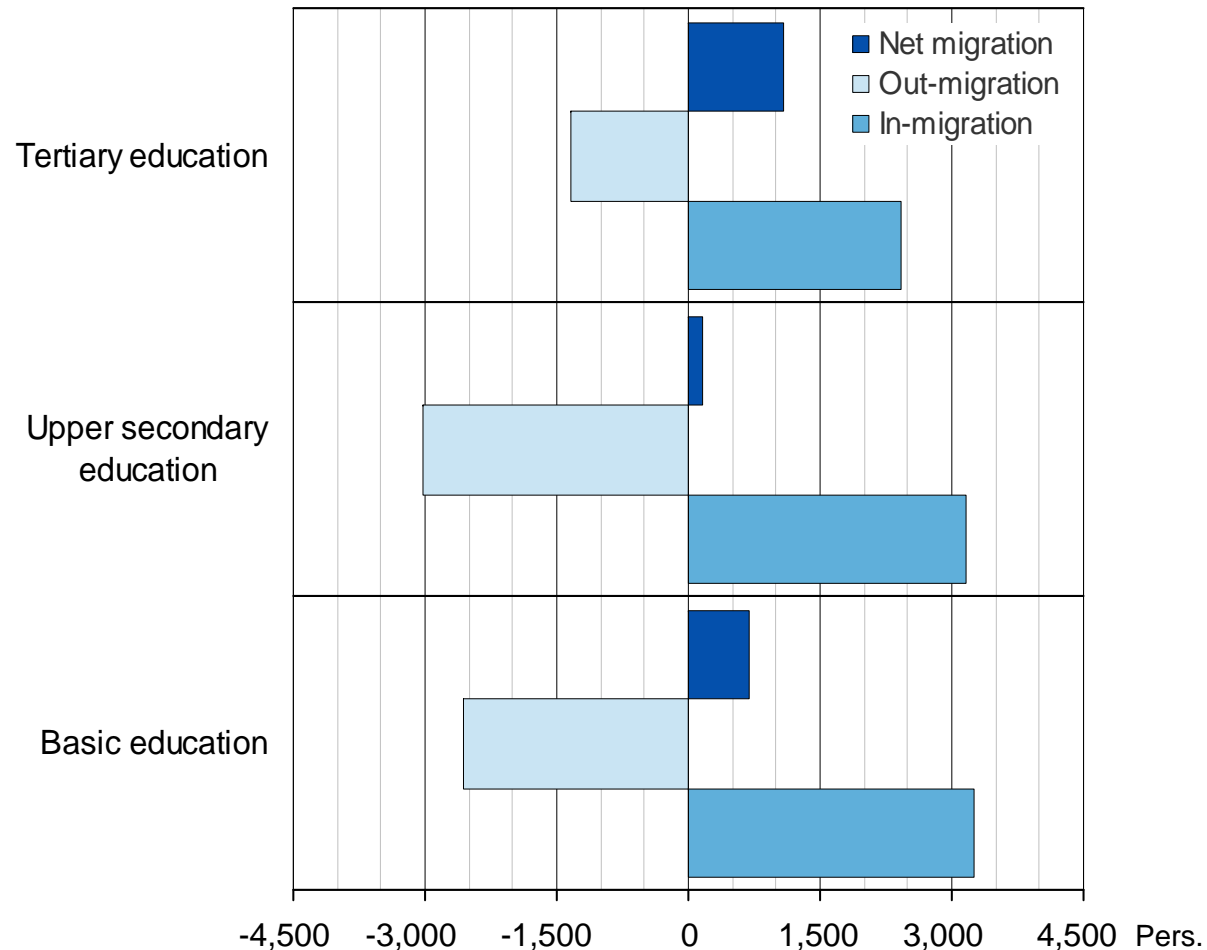




Migration by level of education in Tampere Central Region 2006 (excluding City of Tampere)

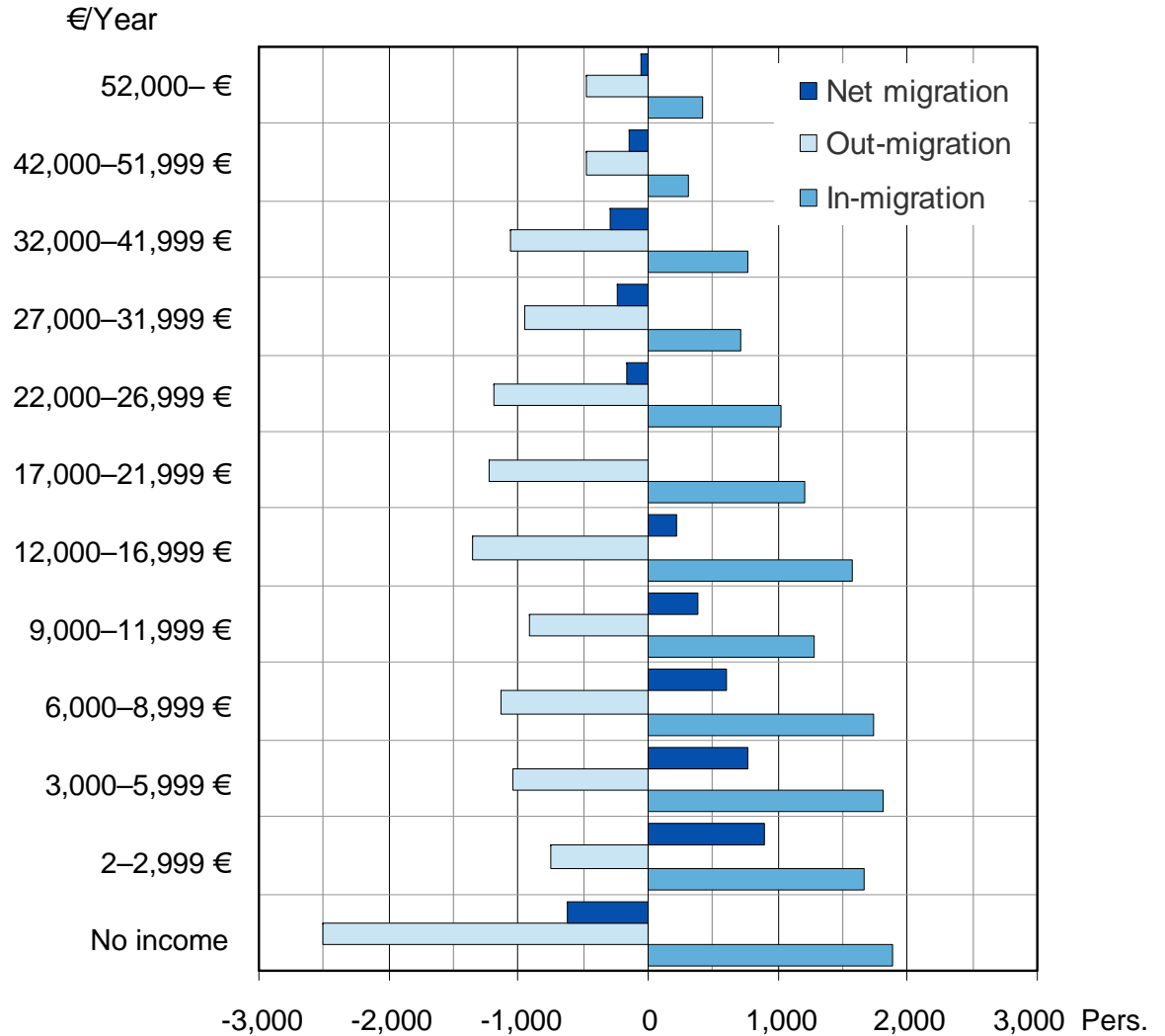

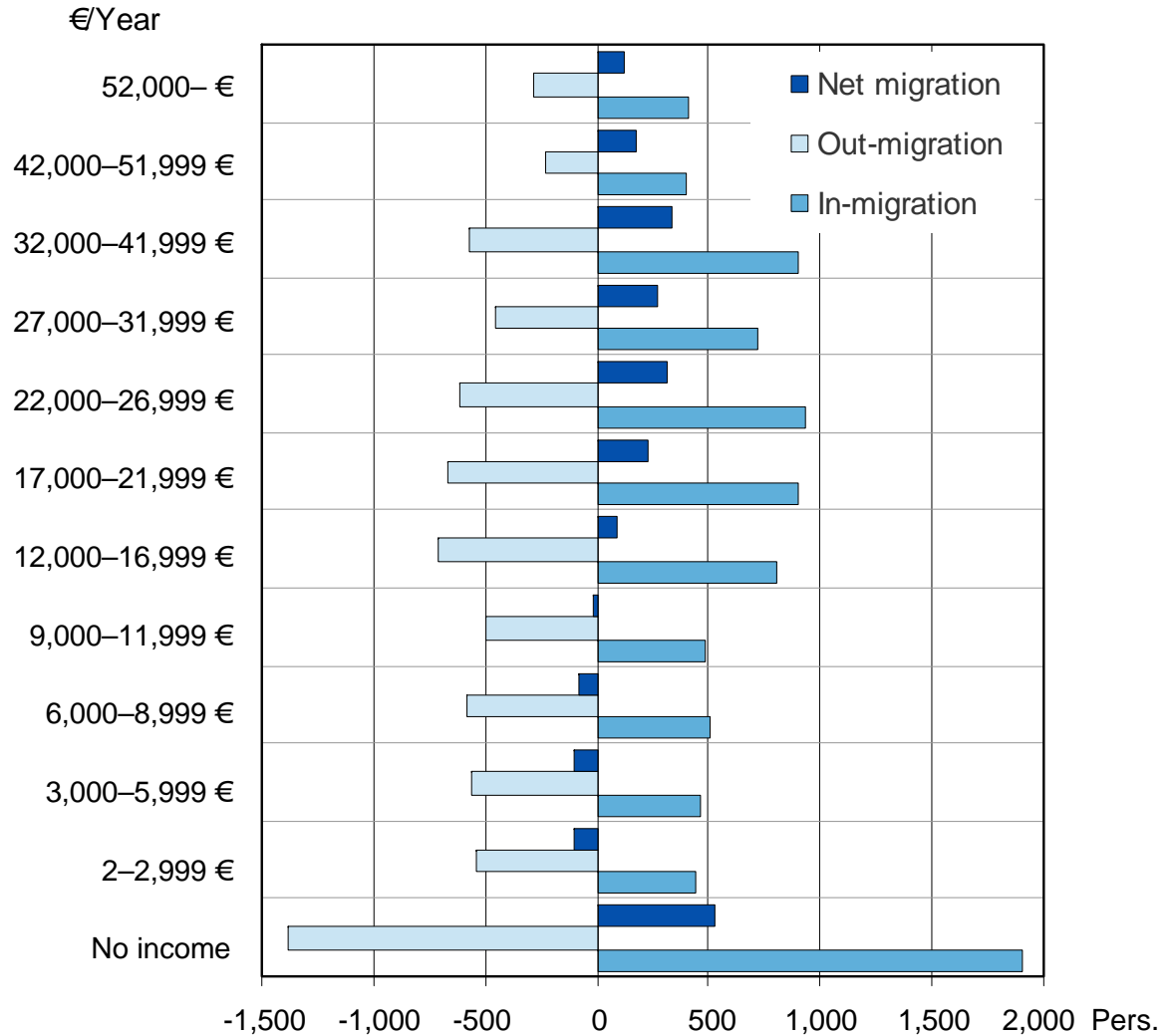

 - Min 12,810 € (Orivesi)
 - Max 19,210 € (Pirkkala)
- Accrued income of Tampere Central Region (excl. City of Tampere)
 - Total +47.2 million €
 - Employed persons +46.3 million €



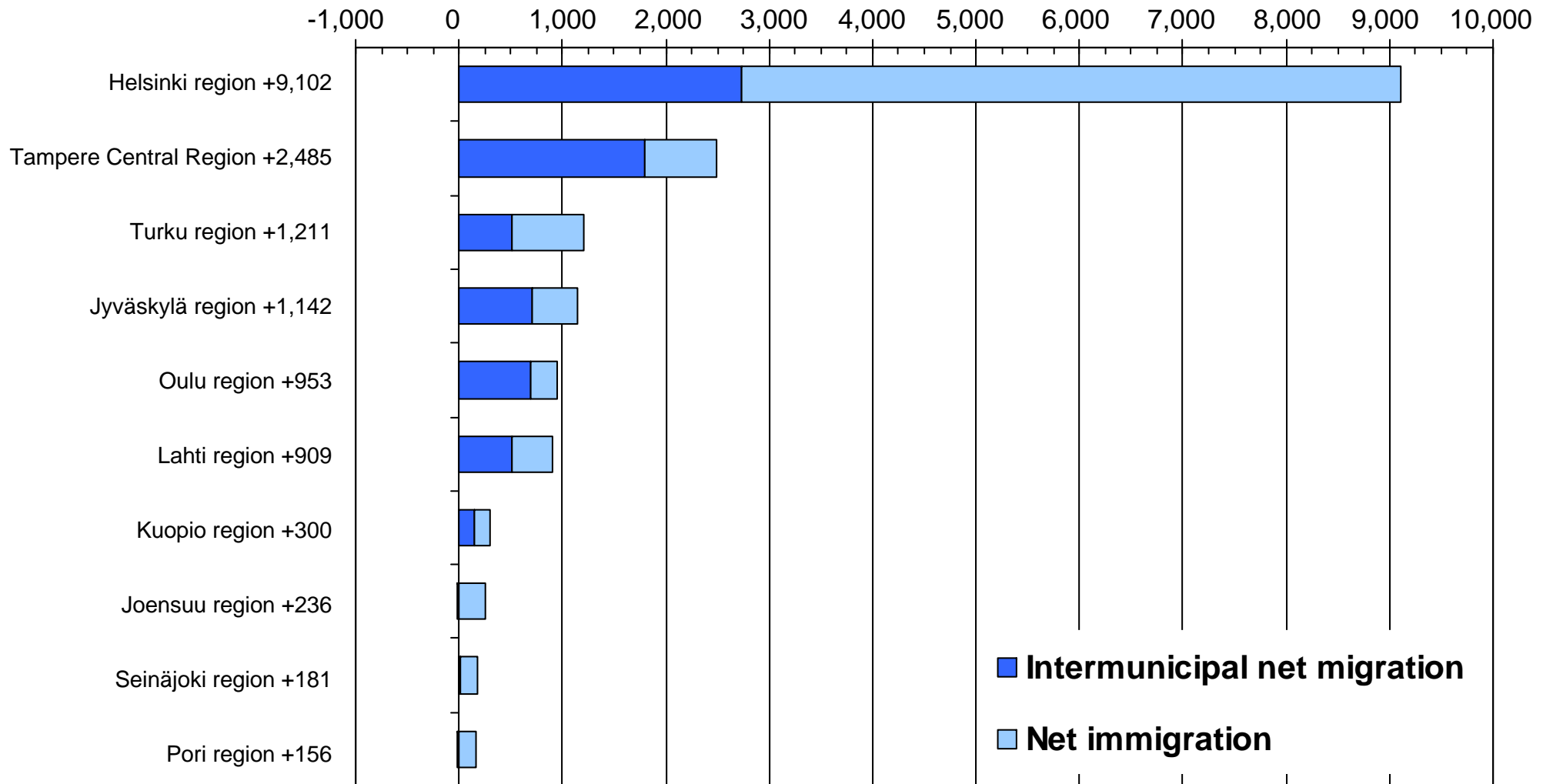

10 regions with largest net migration

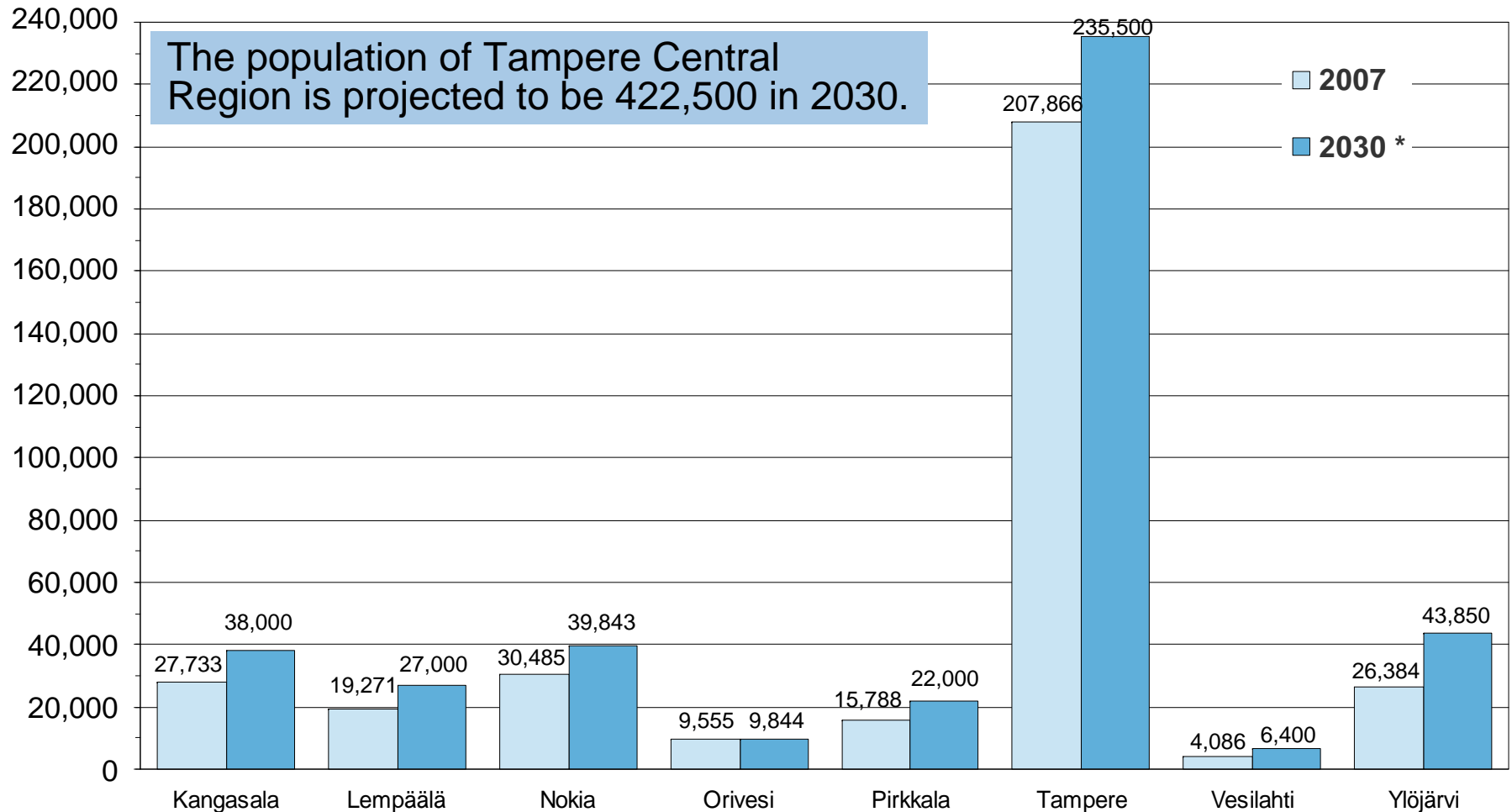

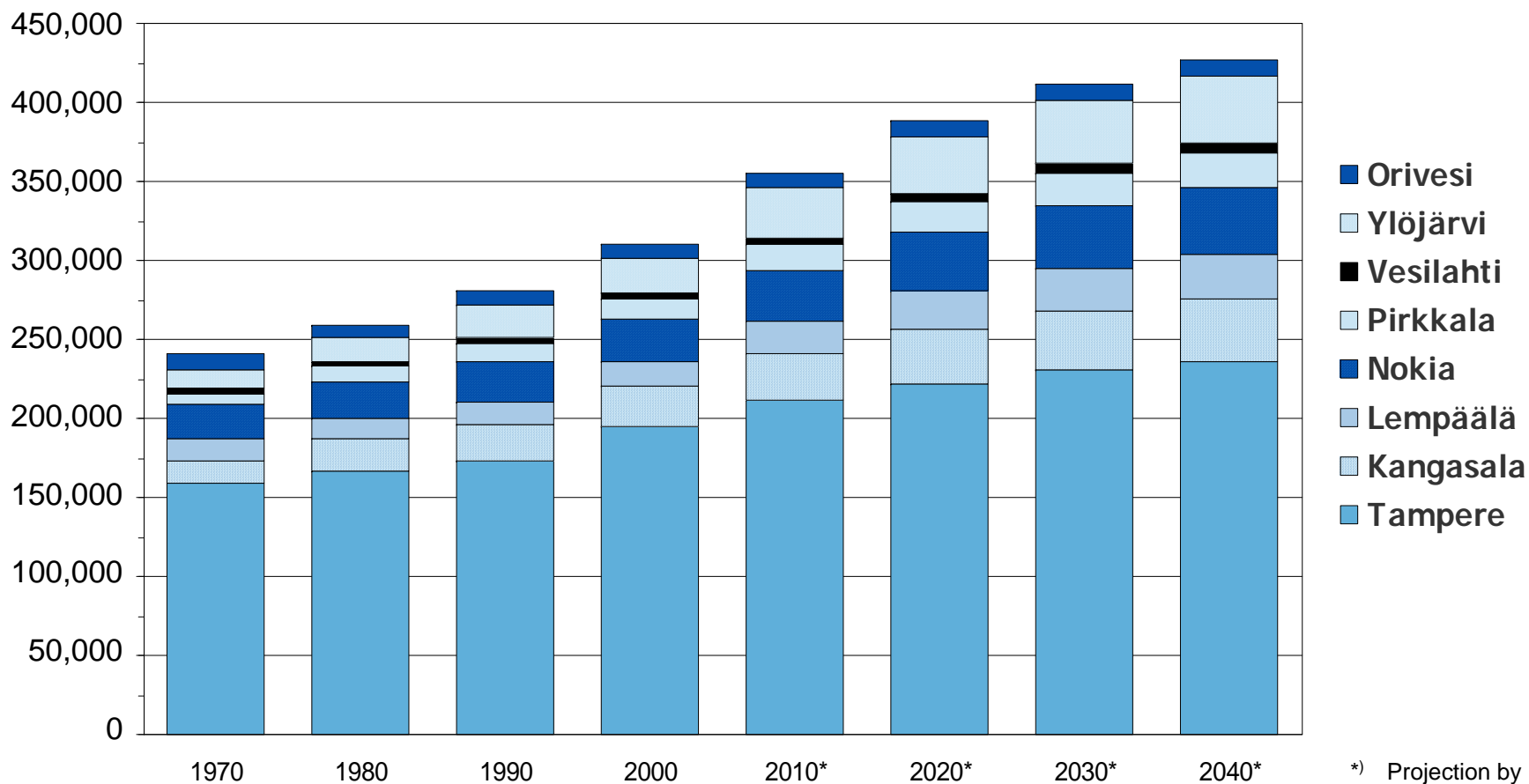

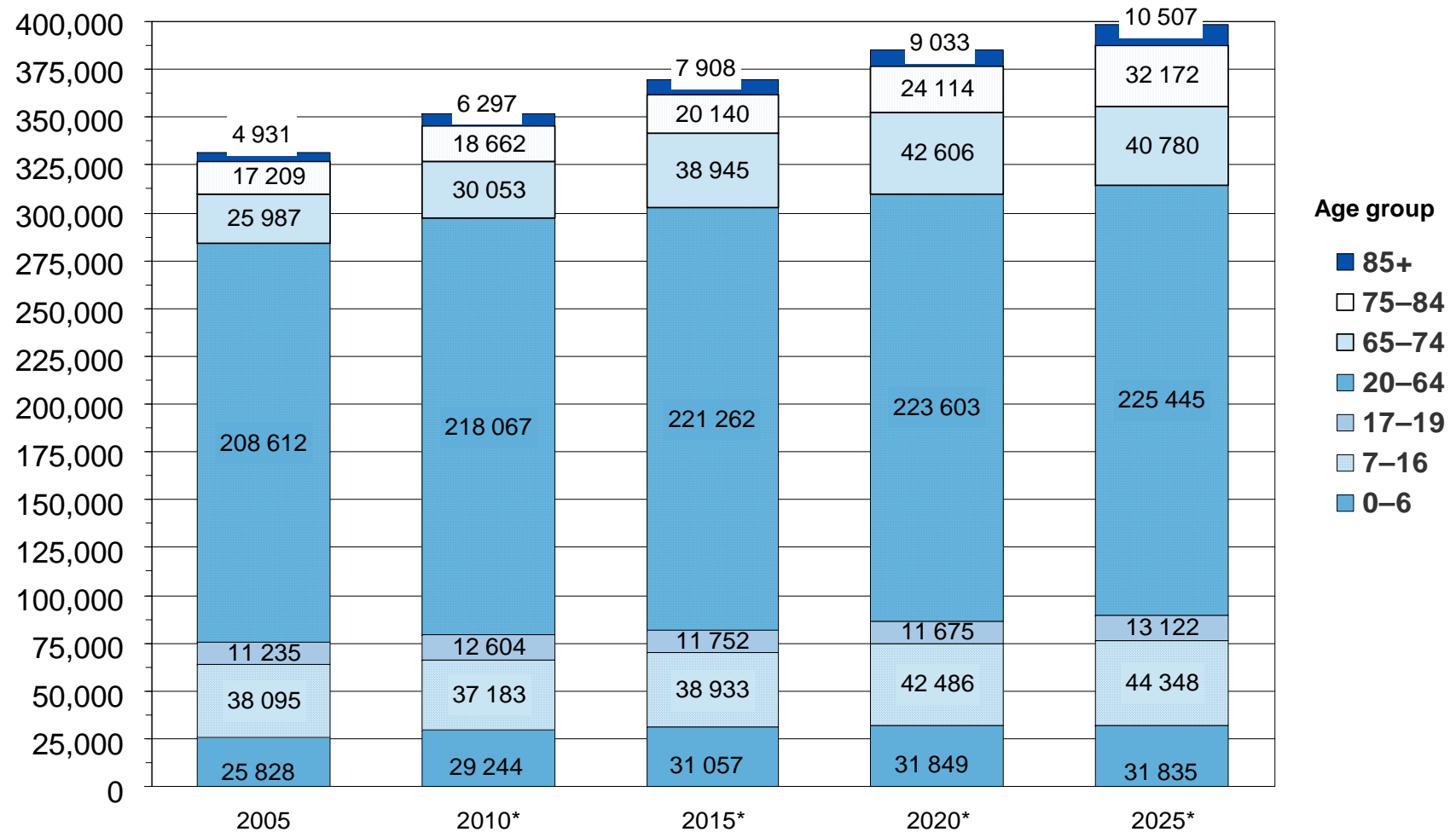

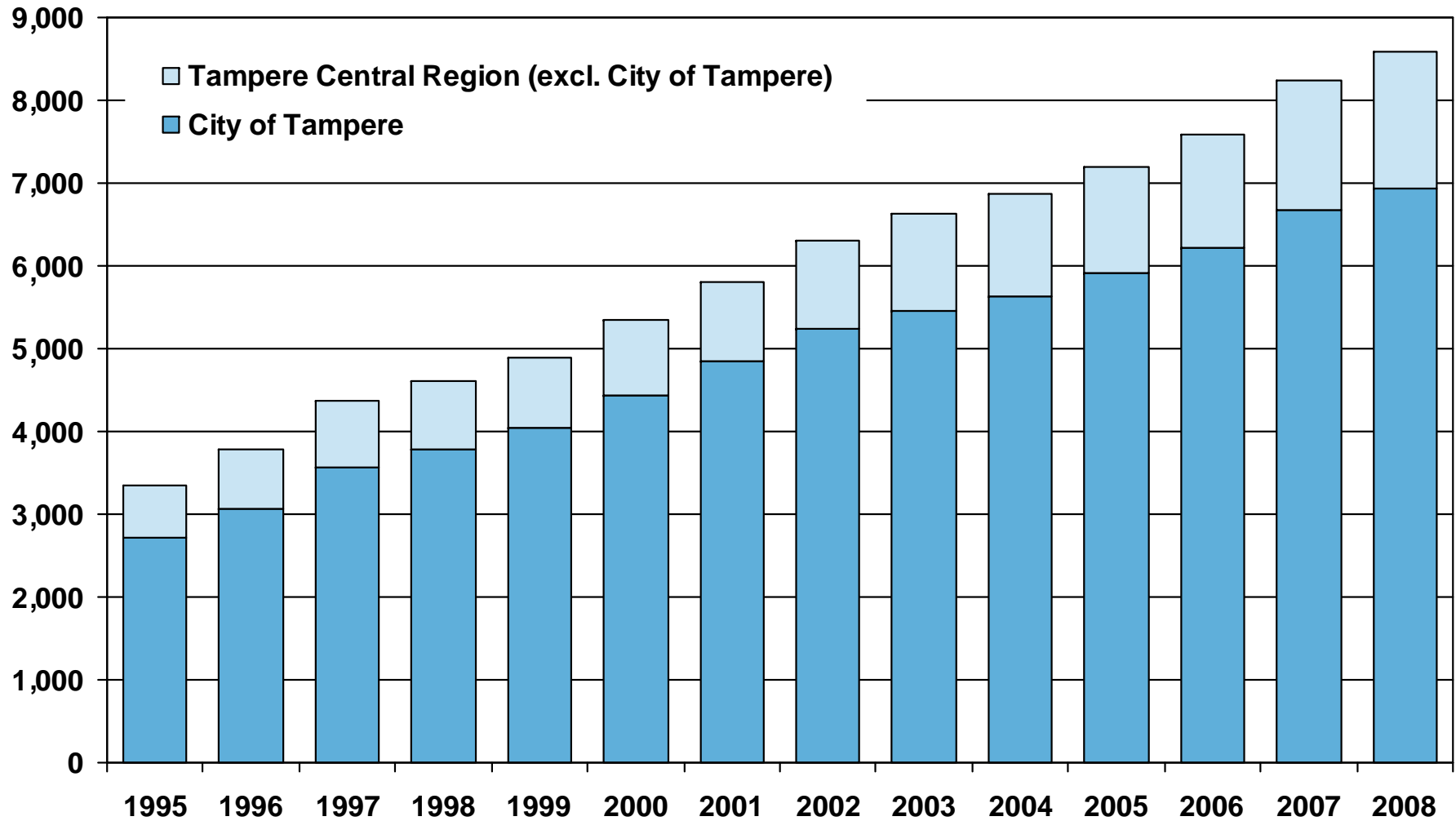

Foreign citizens in Tampere Central Region 1995–2008

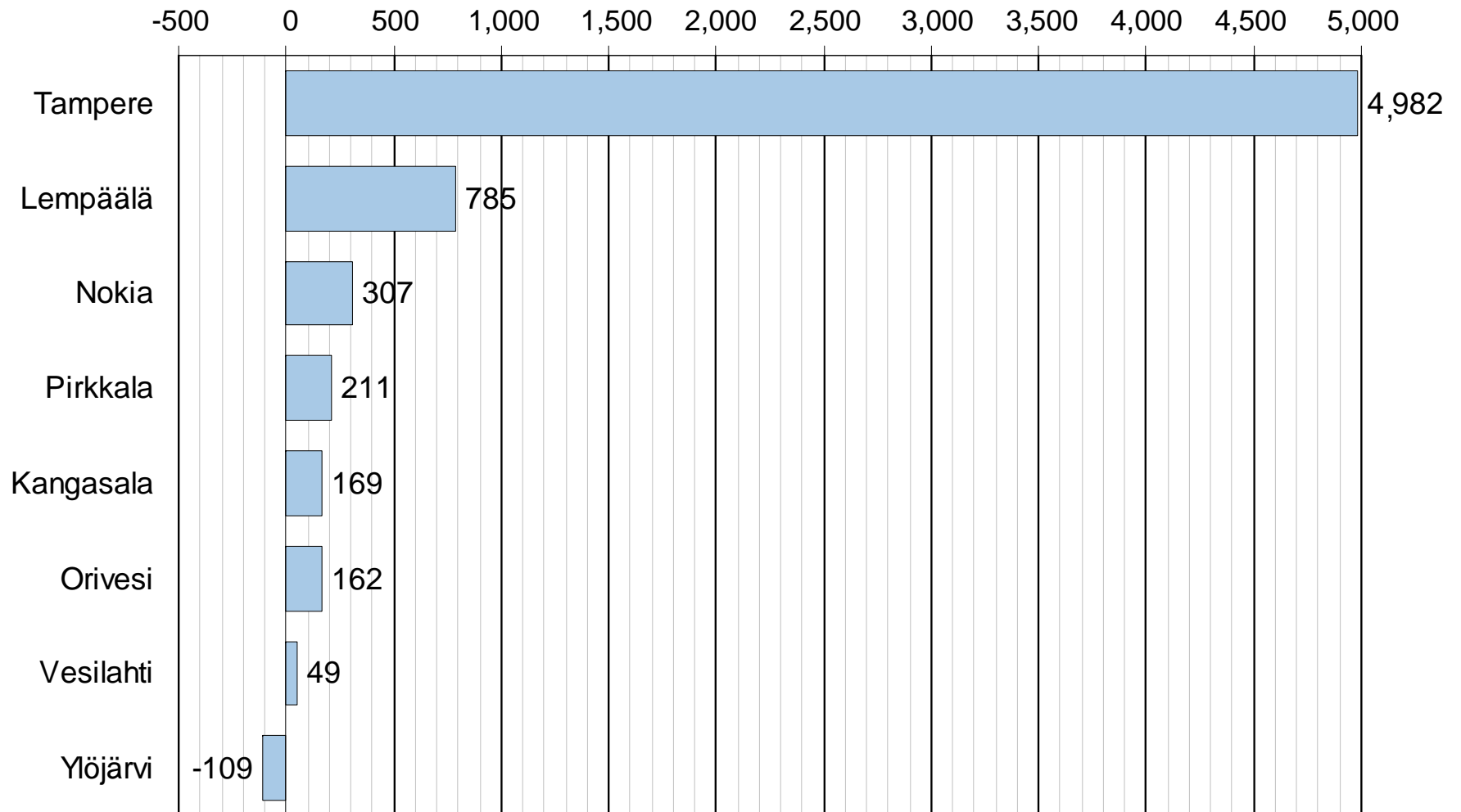

Increase of jobs in Tampere Central Region 2006

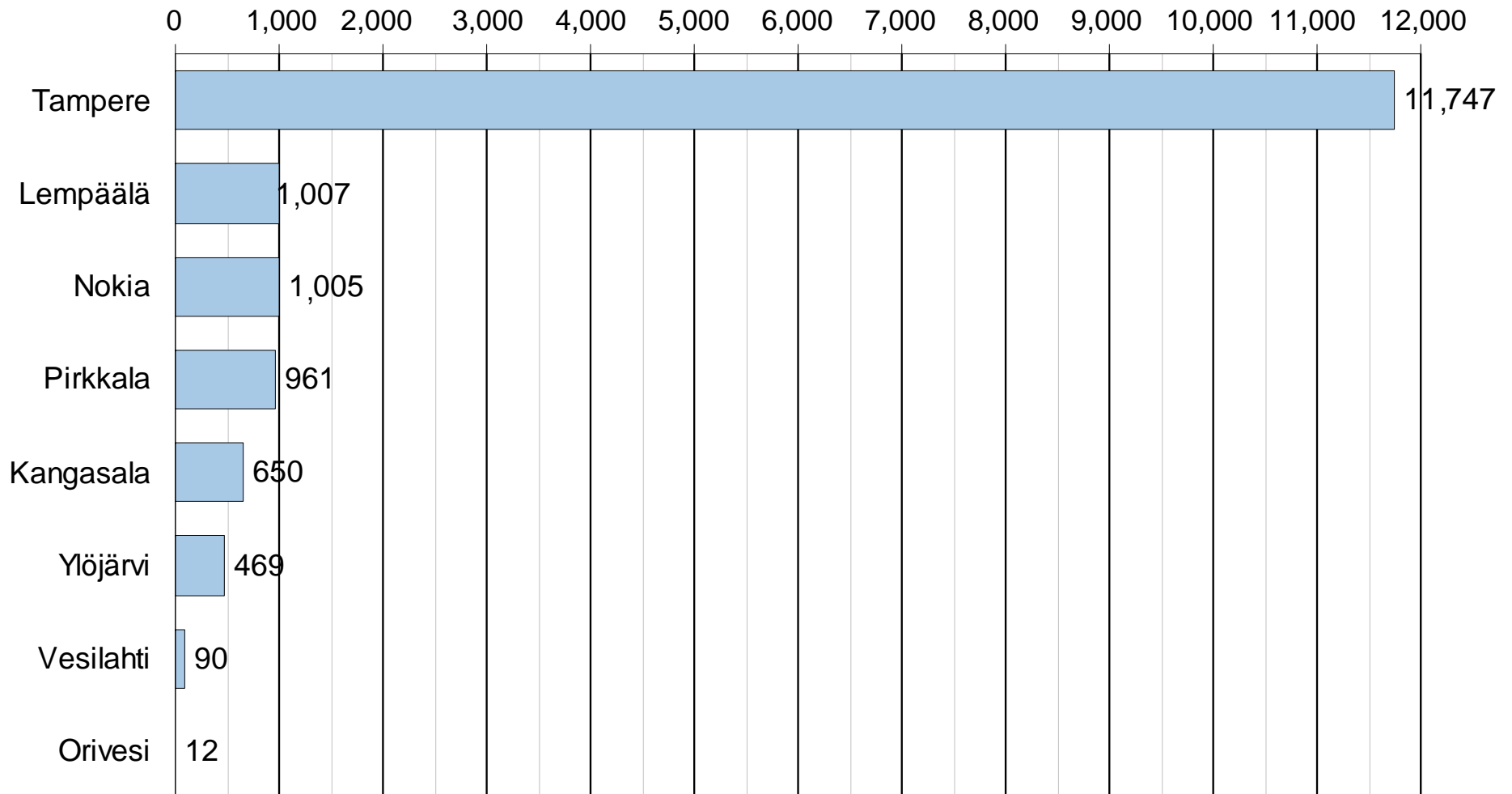

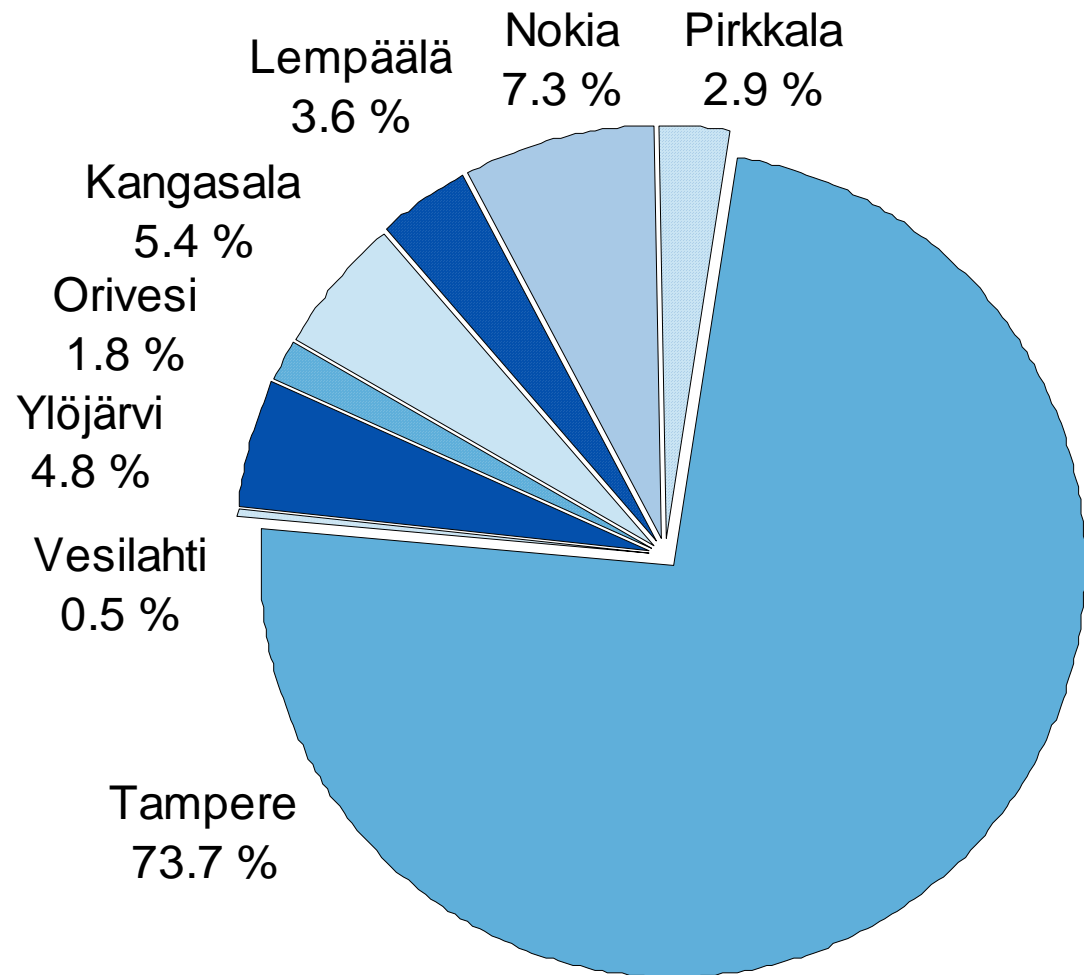

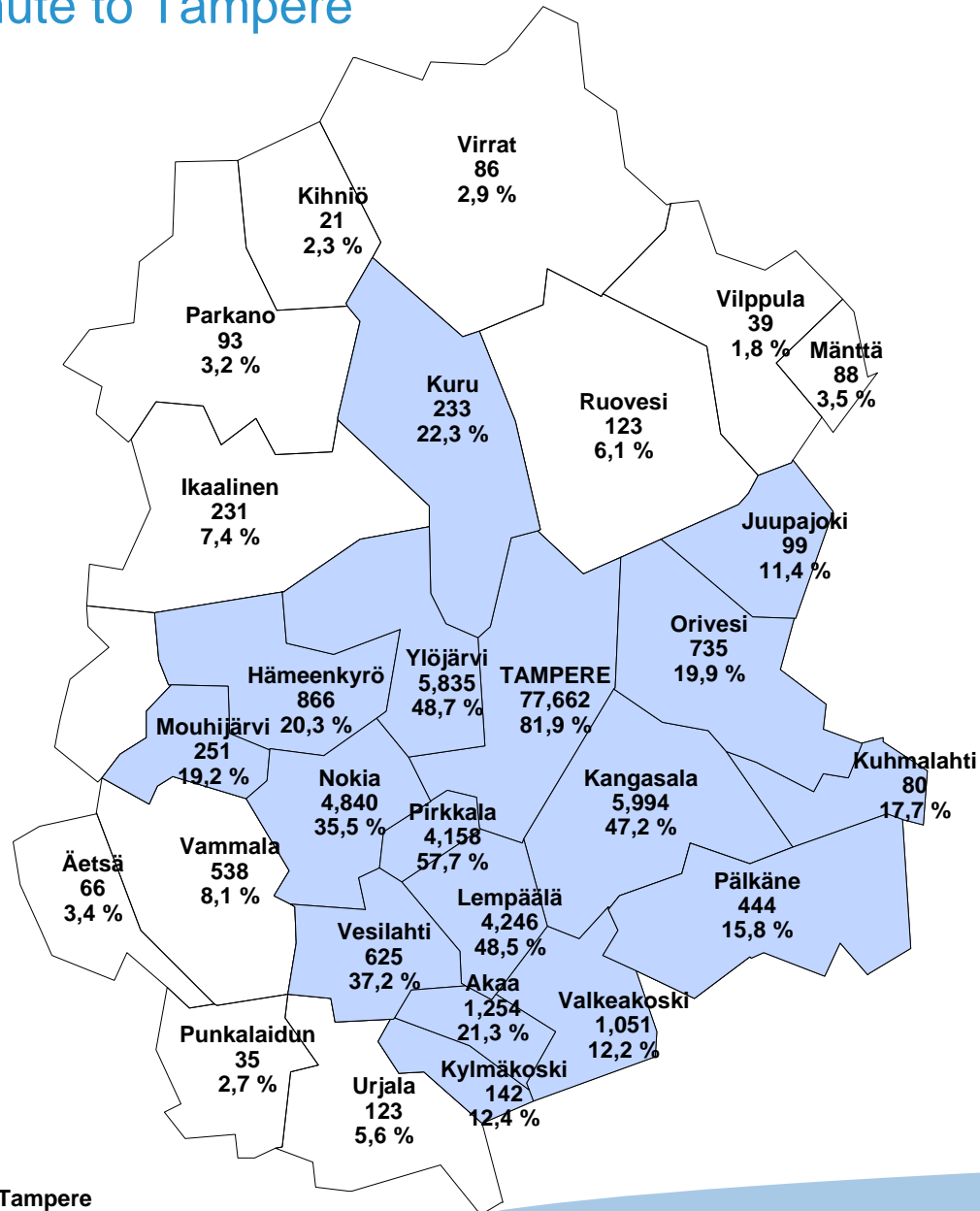

Since 2009 travel-to-work area consists of 14 municipalities due to consolidation of municipalities.

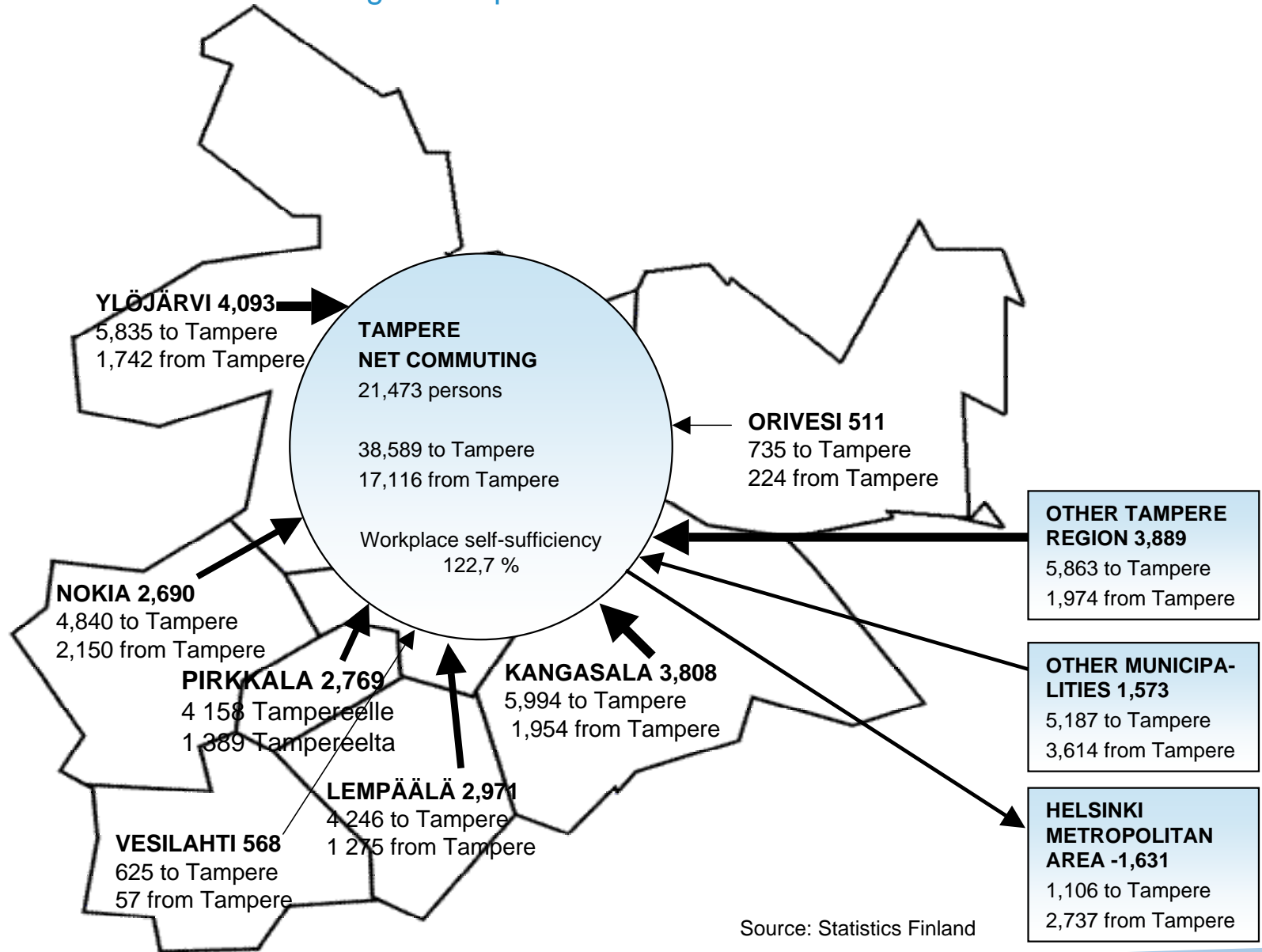

Net commuting = the difference between the numbers working outside Tampere and numbers coming to Tampere to work from elsewhere



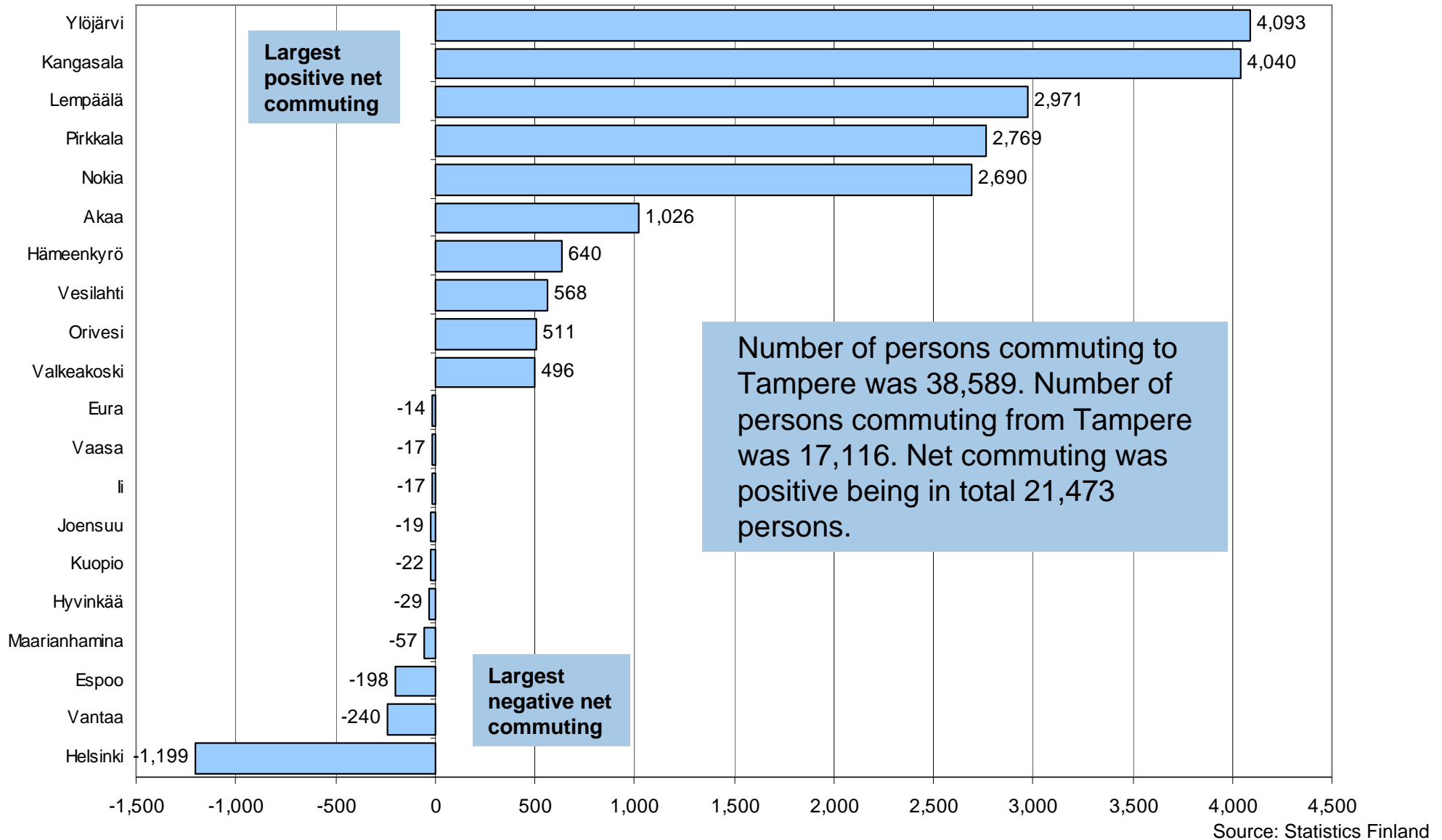

Municipalities with the largest positive and negative net commuting



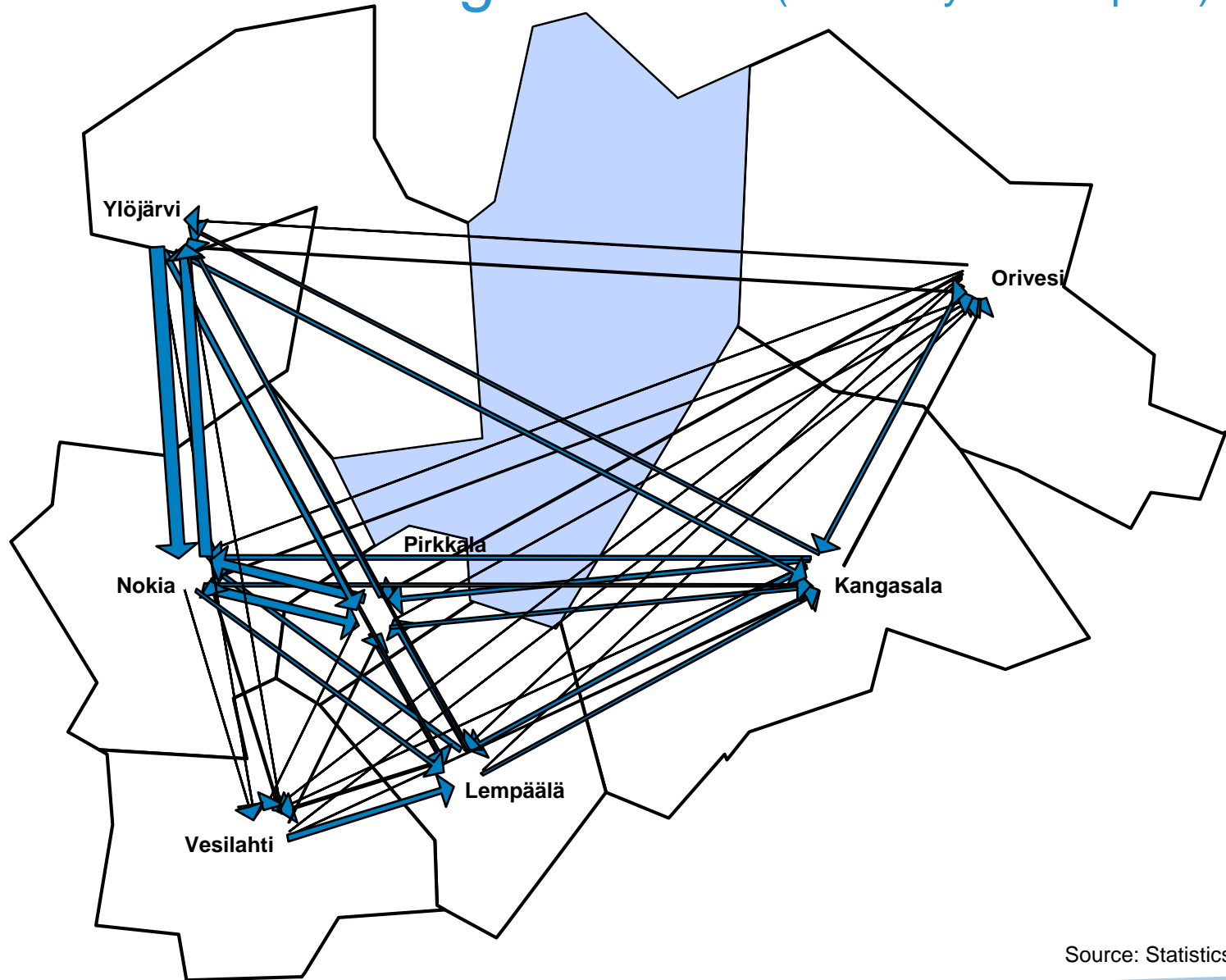
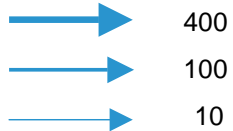

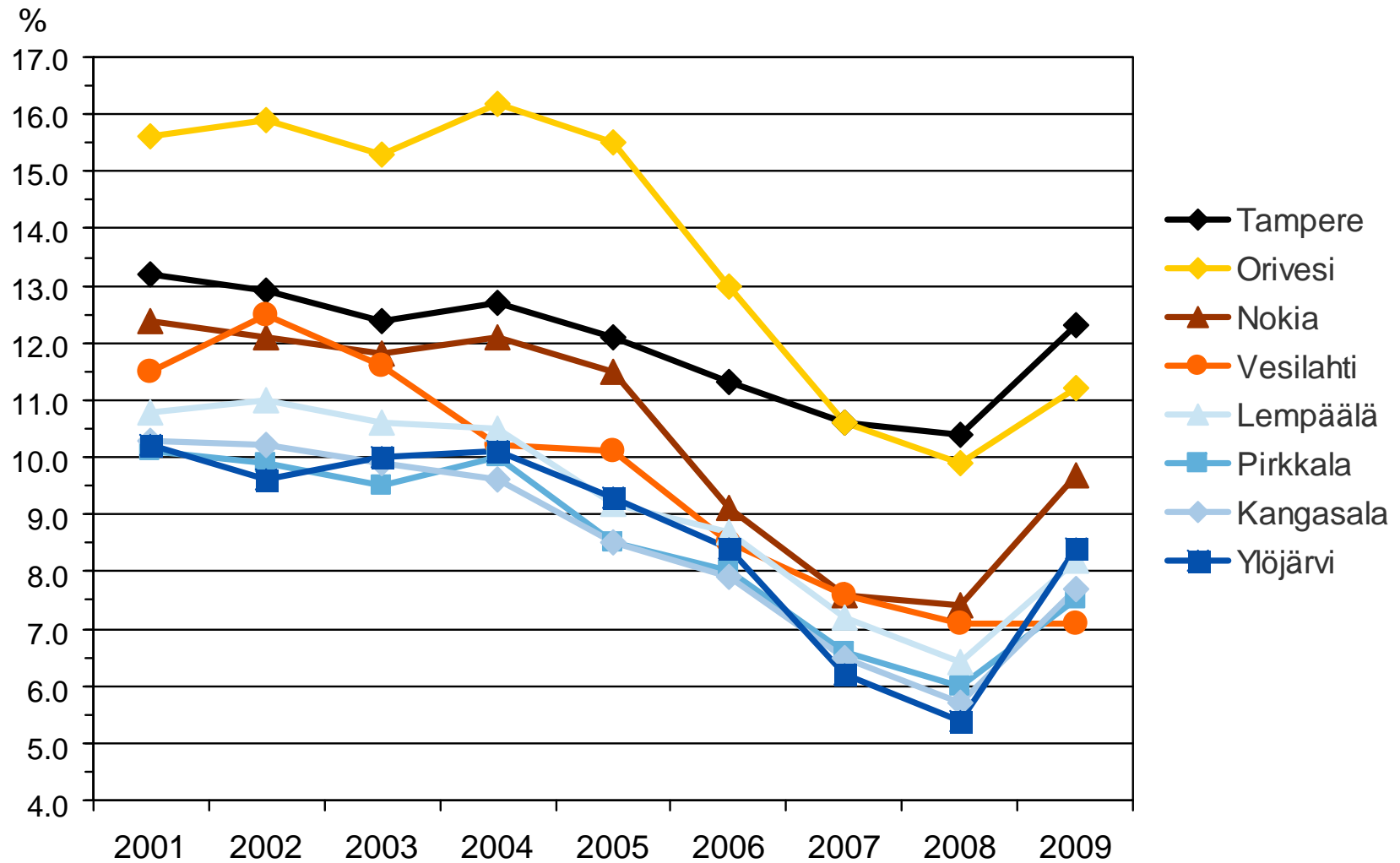

February 2001–2009

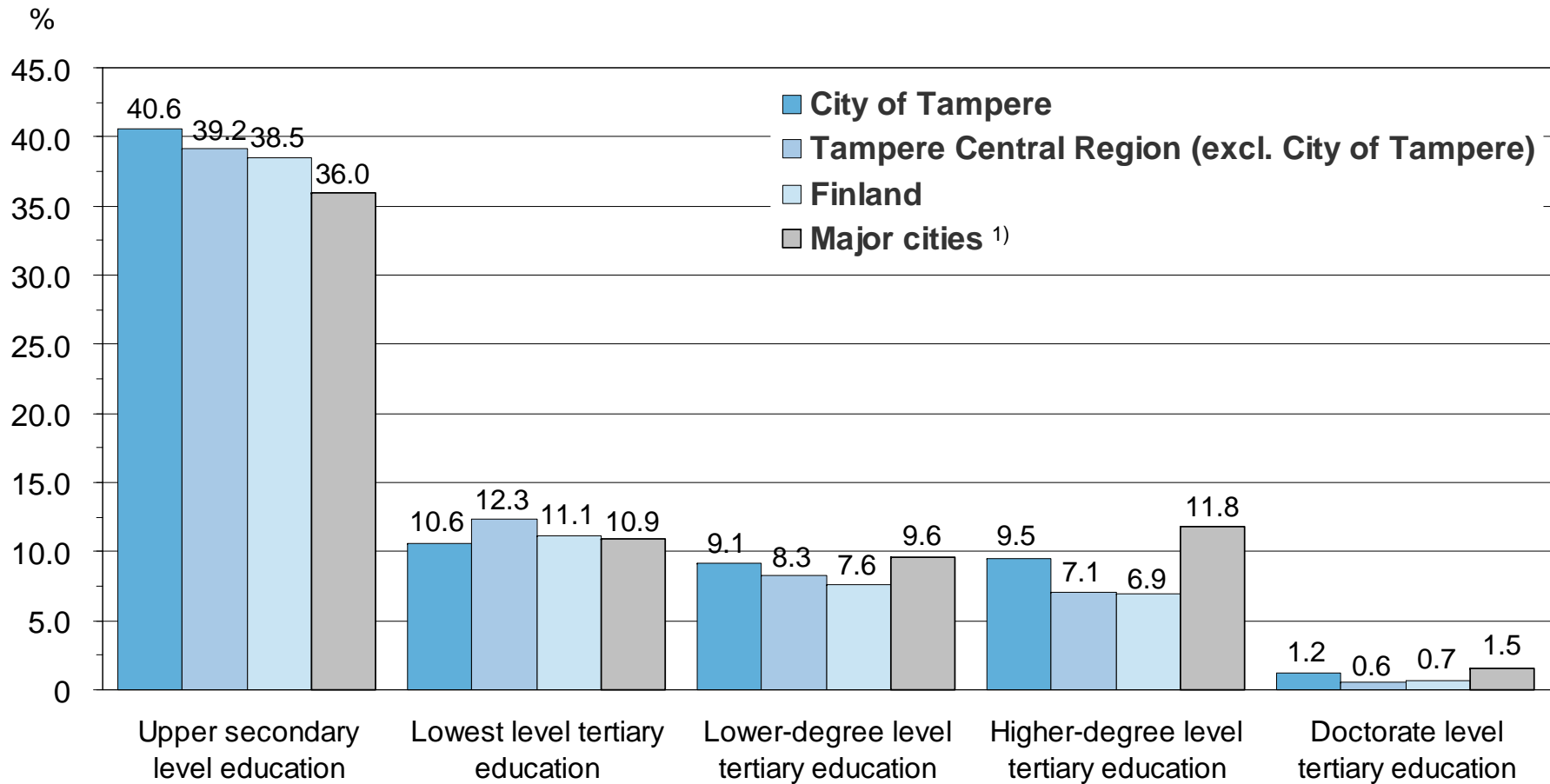

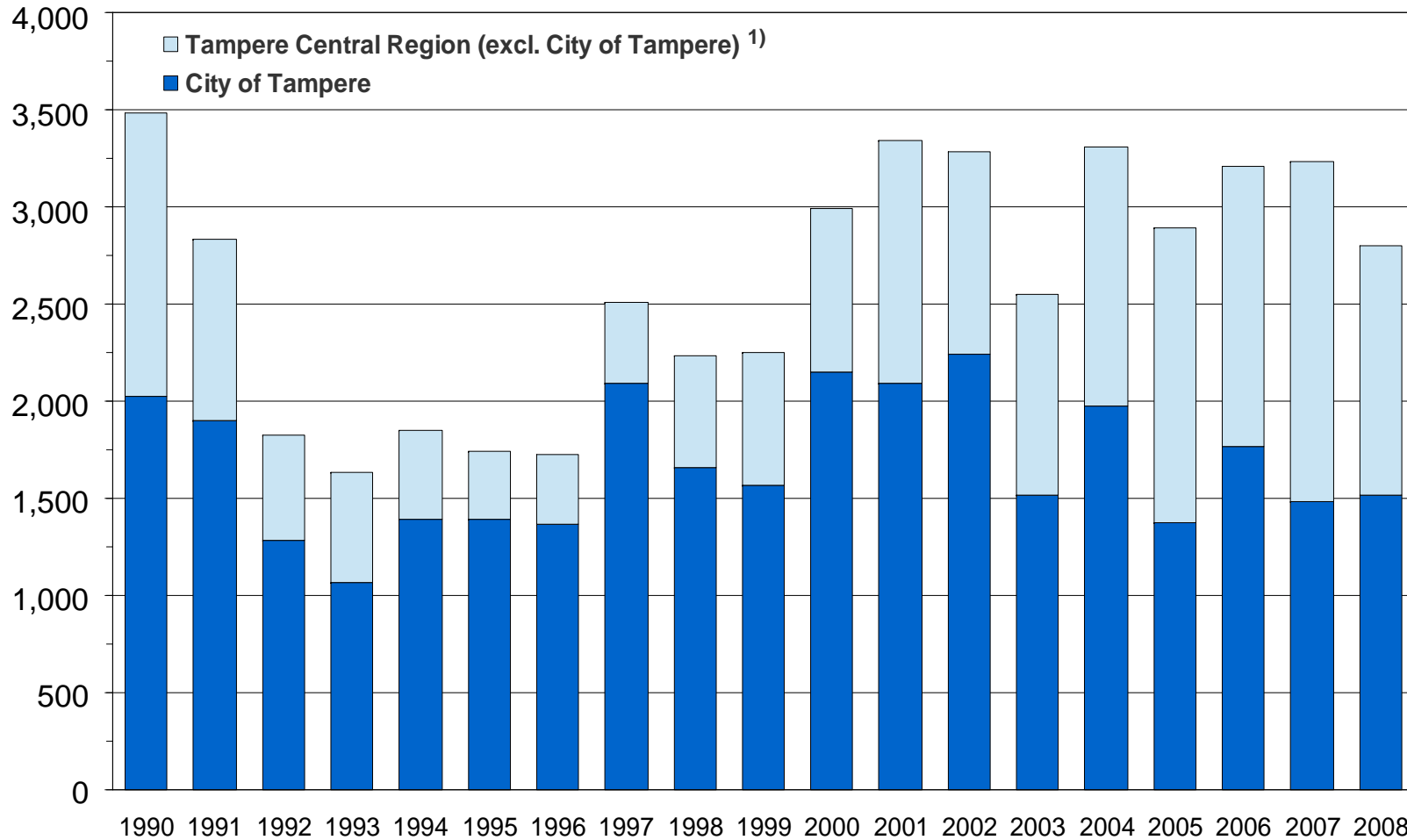

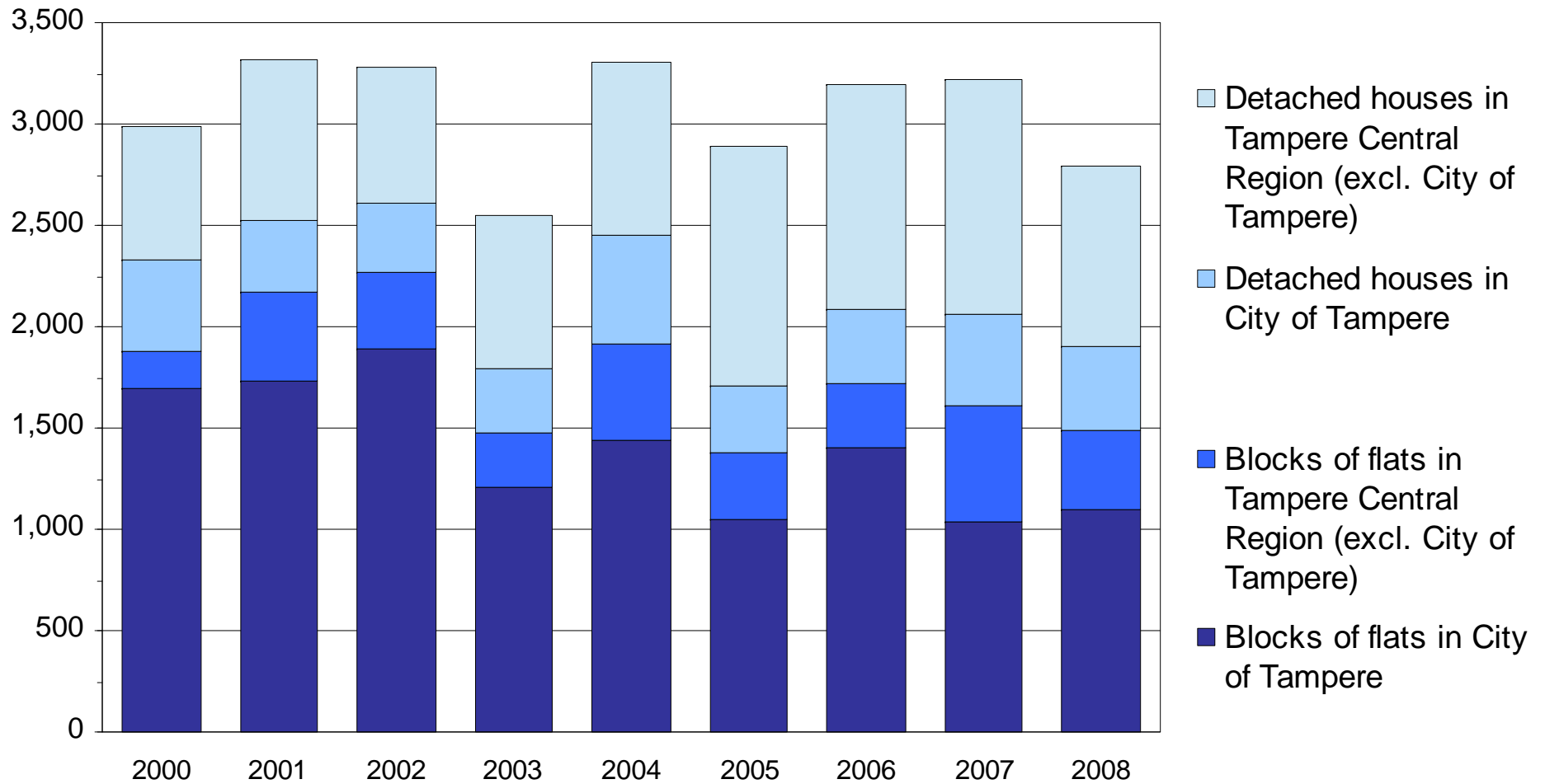

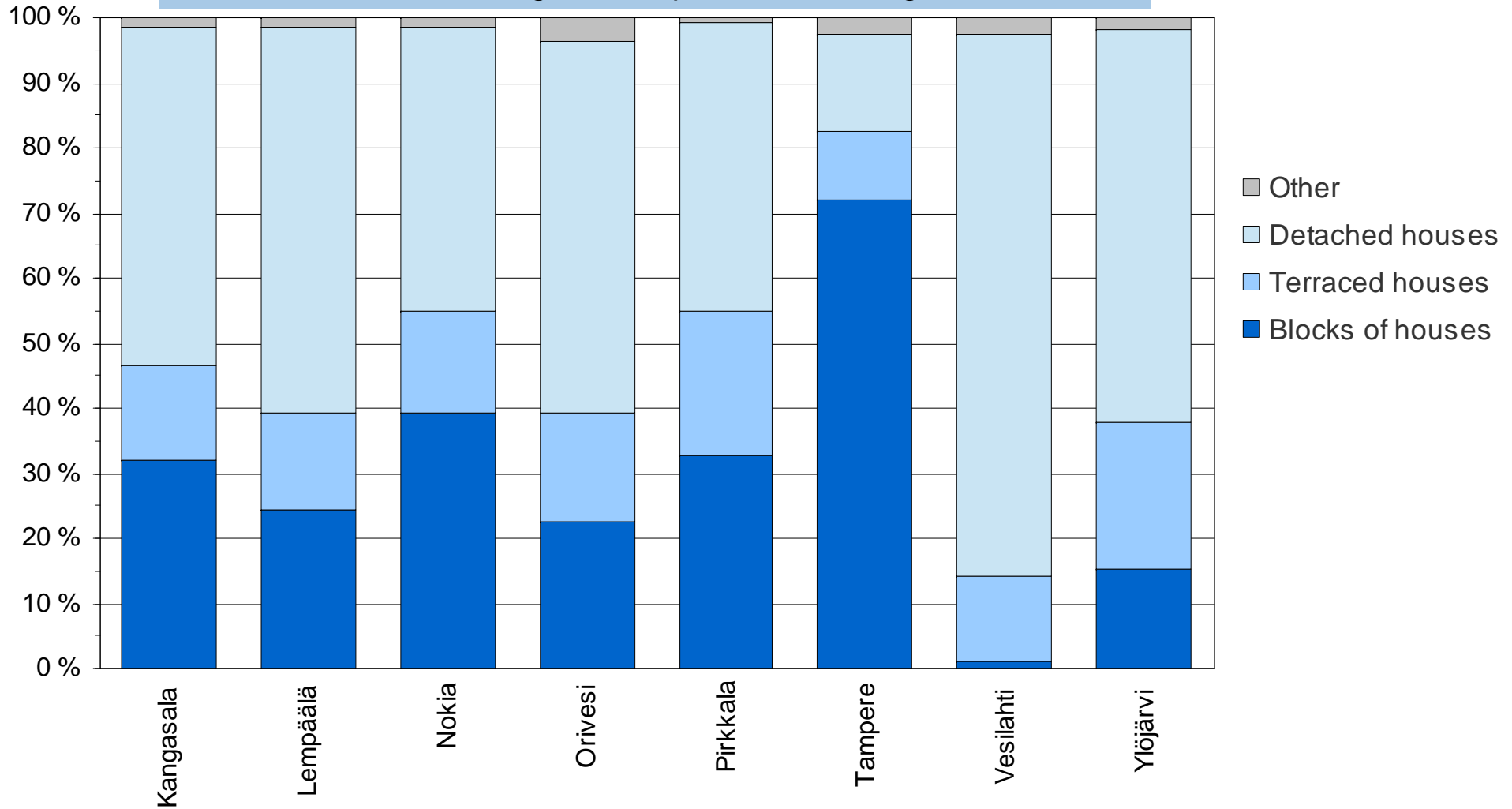

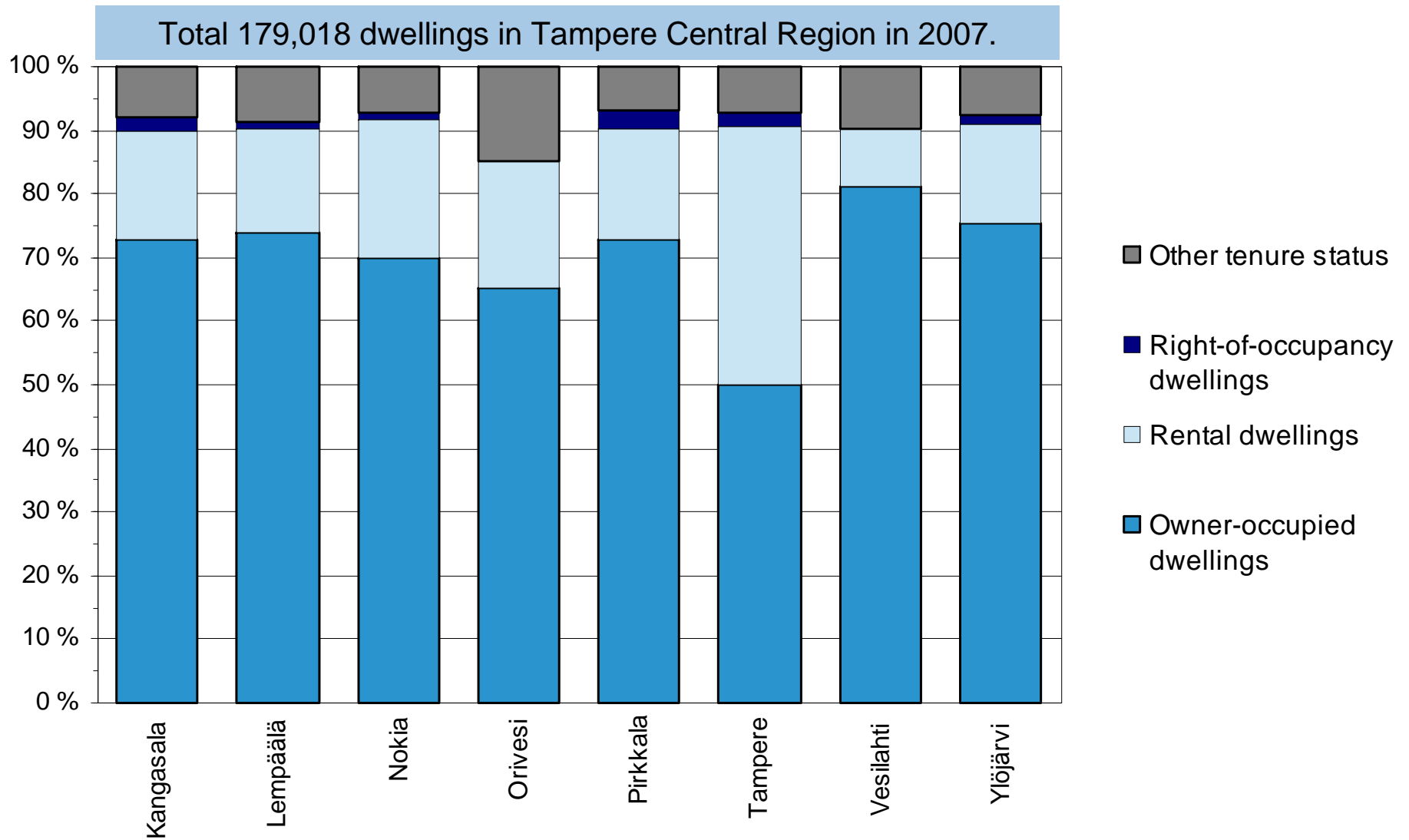

by tenure status

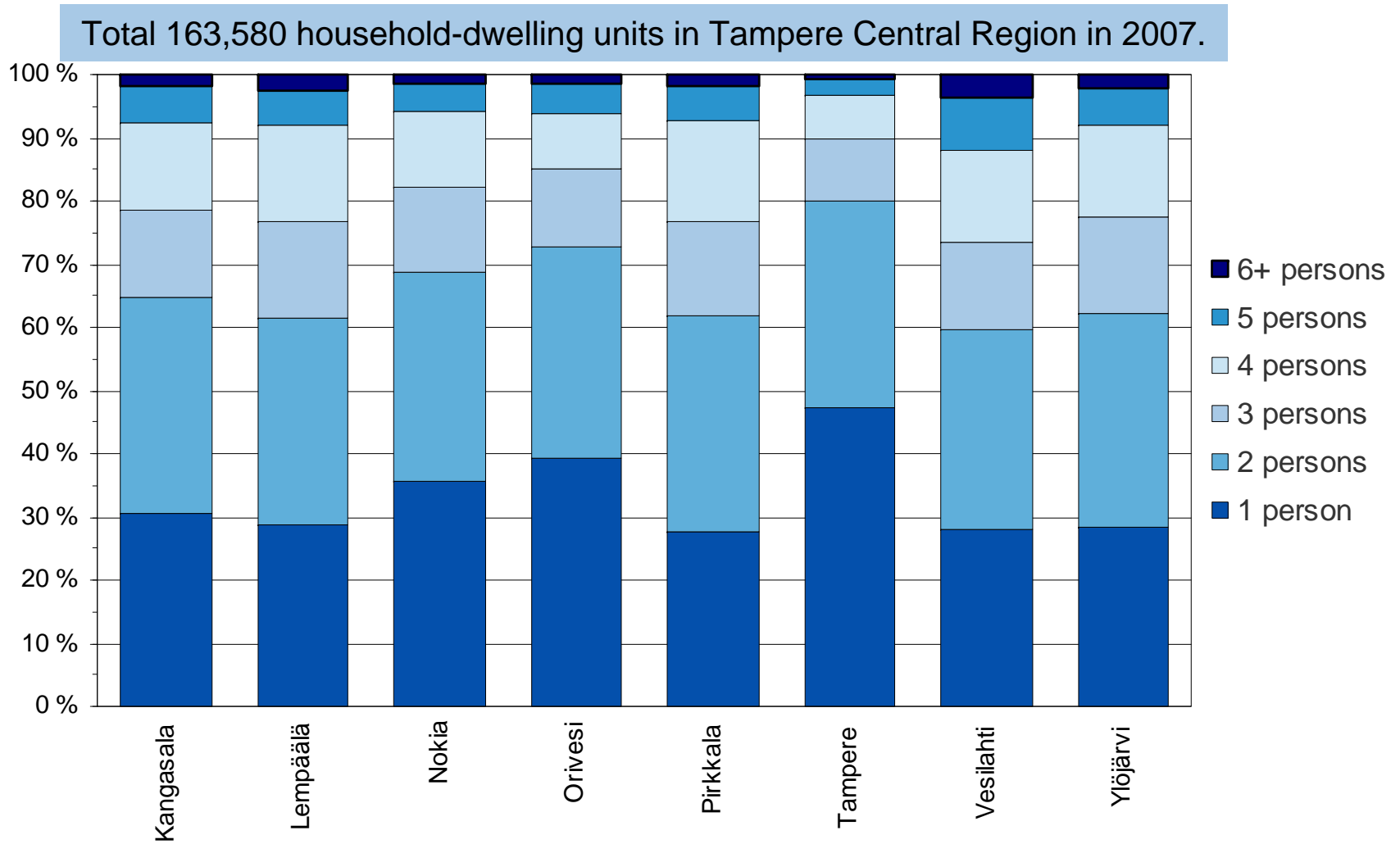

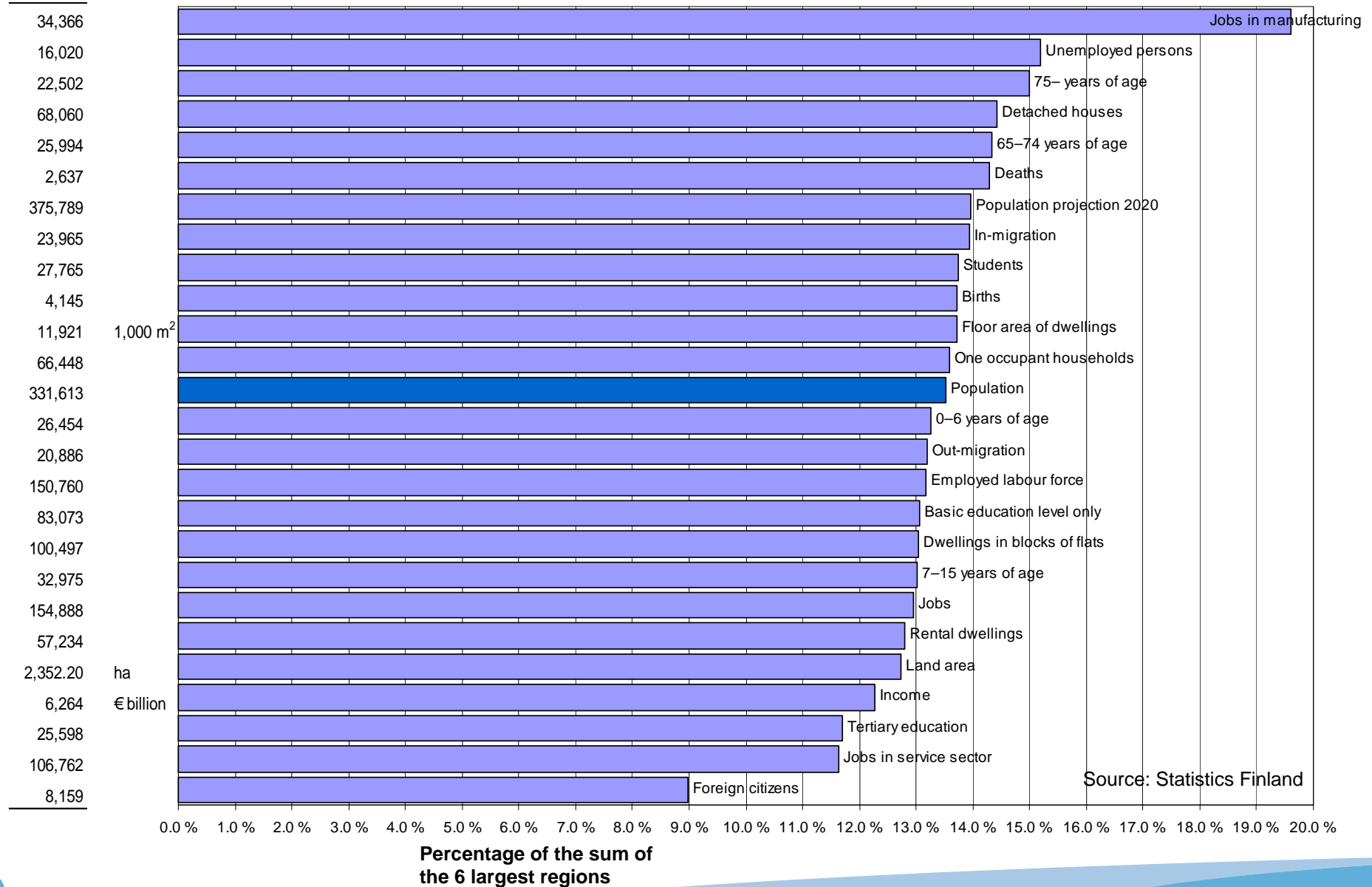




Profile of Tampere region

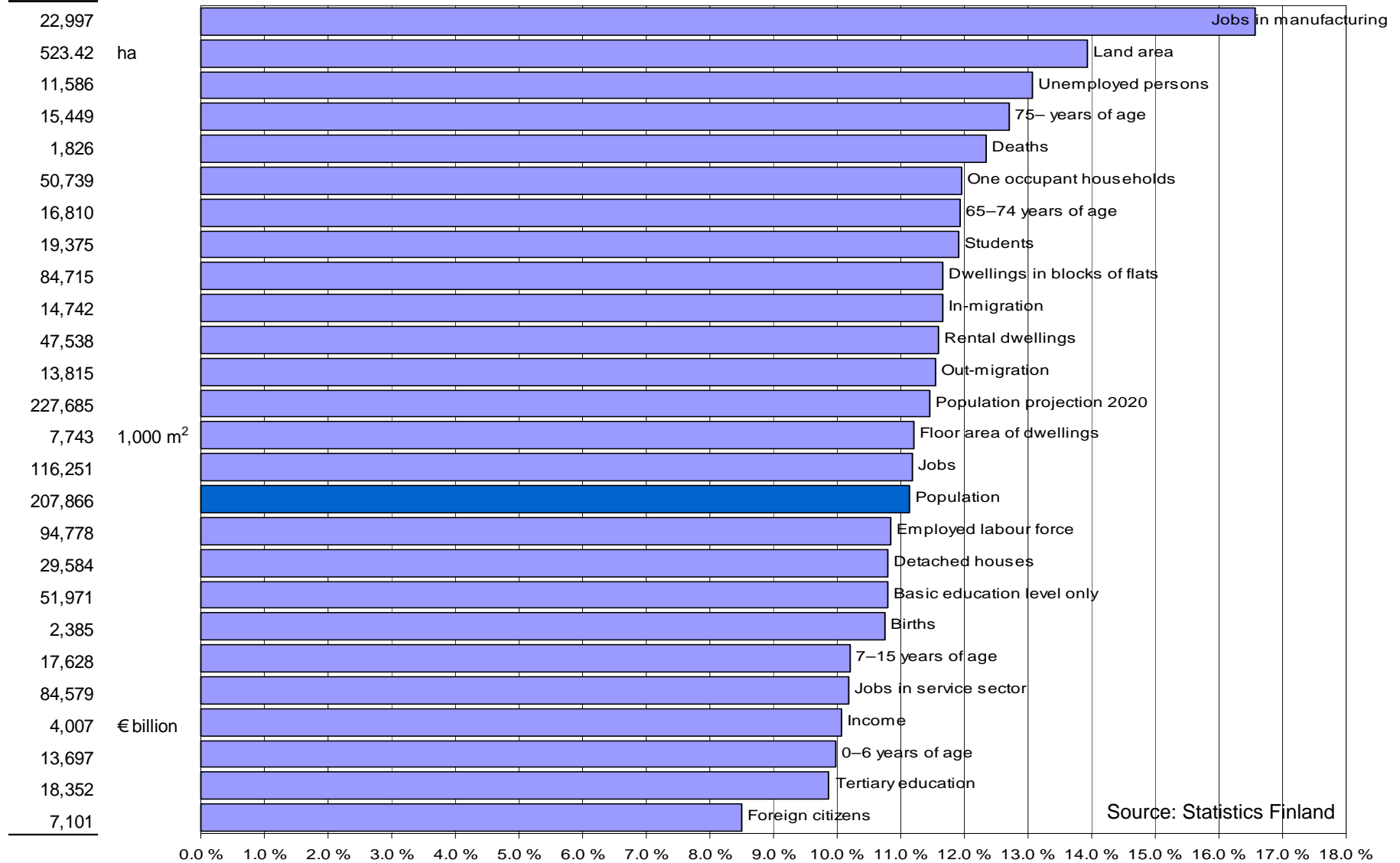




Profile of Tampere
